ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR 2017 – 2018

General Rules applicable to all departments

Procedure for calculation of ‘Best Four’ subjects percentage for Honours Courses

- ‘Best Four’ percentage *will be calculated on the basis English and three academic subjects given in the list below:*
 - Accountancy
 - Biology
 - Biotechnology
 - Botany
 - Business Mathematics
 - Business Studies
 - Chemistry
 - Commerce
 - Computer Science
 - Economics
 - English
 - Geography
 - Geology
 - Hindi
 - History
 - Informatics Practices
 - Legal Studies
 - Mathematics
 - Philosophy
 - Physics
 - Political Science
 - Psychology
 - Sociology
 - Statistics
 - Zoology

- All subjects to be included in the calculation of 'Best Four' must have at least 70% theory component of exam. *In case, the subject to be considered does not have 70% theory component and 30% practical component, then the marks of theory and practical only shall be converted to 70% and 30%, respectively on pro rata basis. These new marks will then be considered for calculation of 'Best Four'.*
- If a candidate has scored: Physics 90 (theory 50, practical 40; max. marks theory 60, practical 40), and Chemistry 91(theory 52, practical 39; max. marks theory 60, practical 40) which is not in ratio of 70: 30, then the marks can be converted on *pro rata* basis

$$\text{Pro rata marks in physics} = 88.3 \left(\frac{50}{60} \times 70 + \frac{40}{40} \times 30 \right) = 58.33 + 30 = 88.33$$

$$\text{Pro rata marks in chemistry} = 89.92 \left(\frac{52}{60} \times 70 + \frac{39}{40} \times 30 \right) = 60.67 + 29.25 = 89.92$$

II. Procedure for calculation of 'Best Four' subjects percentage for B.A (Prog.) /B.Com(Prog.):

- One Language (Core/Elective/Functional)
- One non-listed subject (List above) can be included in calculation of 'Best Four' without any deduction.

Department Specific Criteria

B. Com. (Hons)

- Mathematics is compulsory in Class XII.
- An advantage of 1% is given for each of the following subjects included in the 'Best Four' subjects:
 - Commerce
 - Accountancy
 - Business Studies
 - Computer Sciences
 - Economics

B. Com (Programme)

- An advantage of 2% is given if any two of the following subjects have been studied in Class XII irrespective of whether or not these are included in the 'Best four' subjects:
 - Commerce
 - Accountancy
 - Business Studies
 - Computer Sciences
 - Economics

B.A. (Hons) Economics

- Mathematics is compulsory in Class XII.
- Minimum requirement:
 - English Core 70%
 - Mathematics 70%
- If Economics is included in the 'Best Four' subjects then an advantage of 2% is given in 'Best Four' percentage.

B.A. (Hons) English

- Preference will be given to students from the Humanities and the Science Streams.
- Preference will be given to students who have taken Elective English in their school leaving exams.

B.A. (Hons) Hindi

- Hindi and English are compulsory upto Class XII.
- Minimum marks in Hindi should be 63%.
- 'Best Four' subjects marks should be minimum 60%.

B.A. (Hons) History

- If History is included in the 'Best Four' subjects then an advantage of 2% is given in 'Best Four' percentage.

B. Sc. (Hons) Mathematics

- Mathematics is compulsory in Class XII.
- Minimum requirement:
 - Mathematics 85%
 - 'Best Four' percentage with English and three academic subjects, including Mathematics, should be minimum 80%.

B.A. (Hons) Political Science

- If Political Science has been studied in Class XII then an advantage of 2% is given in "Best Four" percentage, irrespective of whether or not it is included in the "Best Four" subjects.

B.A. (Hons) Psychology

- Advantage of 1% will be given to students who have scored 85% or above percentage in Psychology in class XII, irrespective of whether or not Psychology is included in the 'Best Four' subjects.

B.A. (Hons) Sociology

- If Sociology is included in the 'Best Four' academic subjects then an advantage of 2% is given in 'Best Four' percentage.

B.A. Programme

B.A. Programme with Mathematics as Elective Subject

- Mathematics is compulsory in class XII.
- Minimum marks in Mathematics should be 65%.
- Best four subjects with English and Mathematics should be minimum 70% .

B. Voc - HealthCare Management

- Class XII Passed
- 'Best Four' percentage to be calculated with English and any three subjects.
- Healthcare Sciences is the only vocational subject that can be included in the 'Best Four' subjects.
- Weightage of 2% will be given to candidates having any one of the following subjects in Class XII:
 - Biology
 - Biotechnology
 - Healthcare Sciences (Vocational Subject)

B. Voc – Retail Management & IT

- Class XII Passed.
- 'Best Four' percentage to be calculated with English and any three subjects which may include two vocational subject out of the following:
 - Retail
 - Marketing and Salesmanship
 - Business Operation and Management
- Weightage of 2% will be given to candidates having any one of the following vocational subjects in Class XII:
 - Retail
 - Marketing and Salesmanship
 - Business Operation and Management
