

PLACEMENTS

1. THE PLACEMENT CELL ADHERES TO A STRICT "ONE STUDENT, ONE OFFER POLICY."

2. THE PLACEMENT CELL STIPULATES THAT IT WILL ONLY CONSIDER JOB OFFERS WITH A MINIMUM CTC OF 4.5 LPA*, AND ANY REQUESTS FOR EXCEPTIONS WILL SOLELY BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE FACULTY CONVENORS OF THE PLACEMENT CELL OF JESUS AND MARY COLLEGE.

3. THE RECRUITING COMPANY IS REQUESTED TO FURNISH THE FOLLOWING DETAILS:

- Company Name
- Eligibility Criteria
- Additional Perks/ Benefits (if applicable)
- Job Profiles
- Cost to Company
- Job Description
- Location

4. RECRUITERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO PROVIDE THE PLACEMENT CELL WITH ADVANCE NOTIFICATION OF ALL JOB PREREQUISITES. FULFILLING THIS REQUIREMENT FOSTERS A COLLABORATIVE RELATIONSHIP, ENSURING SMOOTH PROCESSES. IN THE EVENT OF NON-COMPLIANCE, THE CELL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO TAKE CORRECTIVE ACTION AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE.

5. UPON RECEIPT OF THE OFFER LETTER, THE PLACEMENT CELL TRANSITIONS OUT FROM BEING THE POINT OF CONTACT BETWEEN THE CANDIDATE AND THE RECRUITING COMPANY TO FACILITATING DIRECT COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THEM.

RECRUITMENT PROCESS

1. OFFICIAL REGISTRATION, CV SUBMISSION AND WAIVER FORM

Interested students need to officially register for the Pre-Placement Talk and submit their CV/ Resume along with a signed waiver form in accordance with The Placement Cell's guidelines.



2. PRE-PLACEMENT PRESENTATION

Serves as a means to clarify details regarding salary break-up, job profile, job location, bond details (if any) etc. of the company's to enable students to be well-versed with all such details.



3. OPT-OUT WINDOW

Students shall be provided with a specific amount of time to make a well-informed decision as to whether they wish to continue or opt out of the recruitment procedure.



4. SUBSEQUENT ROUNDS OF SELECTION

Several subsequent rounds of selection, such as CV Shortlisting/ Group Discussion (GD)/ Aptitude TEST/ Preliminary Round of Interview etc.



5. FINAL ROUND OF INTERVIEW

Final interview is the final assessment of a candidate's capability, for the specified job role.



6. JOB OFFER

The employer provides an invitation to work in the specified job role. Post that, the official onboarding process commences, which is in accordance with the decision made by the candidate.




