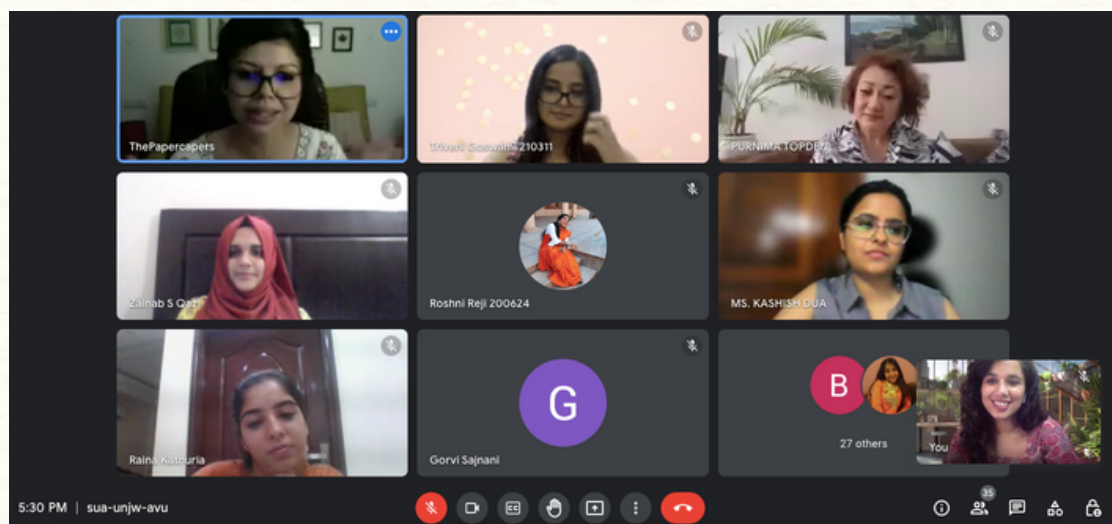

## MEET THE AUTHOR: JANICE PARIAT

Janice Pariat is the author of *Boats on Land: A Collection of Short Stories* and *Seahorse: A Novel*. She was awarded the Young Writer Award from the Sahitya Akademi and the Crossword Book Award for Fiction in 2013. Her novella *The Nine Chambered-Heart*, bestselling in India, was published in the UK and in ten other languages including Italian, Spanish, French, and German. She studied English Literature at St Stephen's College, Delhi, and History of Art at the School of Oriental and African Studies, London. Her work—including art reviews, book reviews, fiction and poetry—has featured in a wide selection of national magazines and newspapers. In 2014, she was the Charles Wallace Creative Writing Fellow at the University of Kent, UK, and a Writer in Residence at the TOJI Residency in South Korea in 2019. Her novel *Everything the Light Touches* is forthcoming with HarperCollins India, Borough Press UK, and HarperVia USA in October 2022. Currently, she lives between Shillong and New Delhi with a cat of many names.

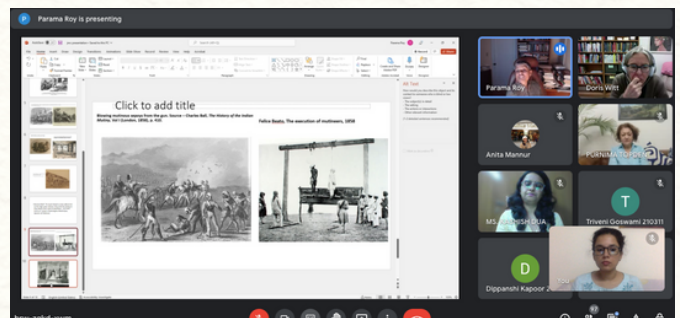
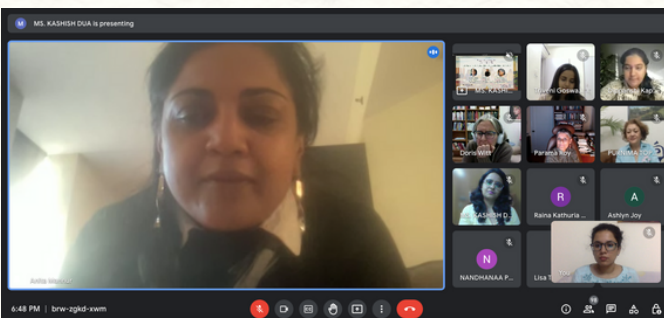
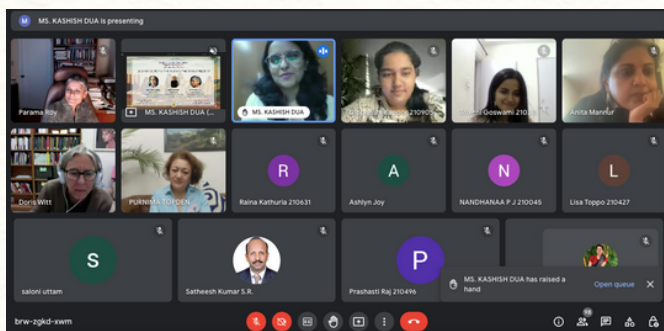
**PROF. DORIS WITT**

Parama Roy is Professor Emerita of English at the University of California, Davis. She is the author of *Indian Traffic: Identities in Question in Colonial and Postcolonial India* (UC Press, 1998) and *Alimentary Tracts: Appetites, Aversions, and the Postcolonial* (Duke UP, 2010), and co-editor of *States of Trauma: Gender and Violence in South Asia* (Zubaan, 2009). Her current book project, on the economies (and aneonomies) of sacrifice across human and other than human worlds in the nineteenth- and twentieth-century Britain and its empire, is titled "Species, Sacrifice, and the Question of Empire."

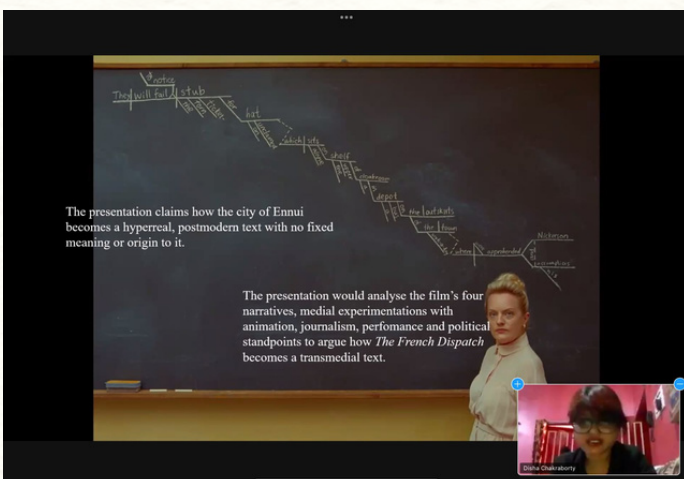

Ms Perkins' first book was a short story collection *Not Her Real Name*, which won the Geoffrey Faber Memorial Prize. Her novels include *Novel About My Wife*, winner of the Believer Book of the Year Award and the Montana Medal for Fiction, the Women's Prize longlisted *The Forrests*, and the forthcoming *Lioness* (Bloomsbury, 2023). She is co-editor of *The Fuse Box*, a collection of essays on the writing process.

Her writing for stage and screen includes the original play *The Made* and an adaptation of Henrik Ibsen's *A Doll's House*, both with Auckland Theatre Company. She co-wrote the feature film adaptation of Eleanor Catton's novel *The Rehearsal*.

She has been Senior Lecturer in Creative Writing at the Institute of Modern Letters, Victoria University of Wellington.

Emily's broadcasting work includes presenting *The Book Show* and *The Good Word* on TVNZ7. She is a member of the Folio Academy, an Arts Foundation Laureate, and in 2017 was made a Member of the New Zealand Order of Merit for services to literature.

Dr. Aria S. Halliday is an award-winning author who specializes in the cultural constructions of Black girlhood and womanhood in material, visual, and digital culture in the late 20th and early 21st centuries. She engages broad interdisciplinary interests in girlhood, Black feminism, radicalism, consumerism, and performance in Black popular culture in the United States and the Caribbean. Her research is published in *Cultural Studies*, *Departures in Critical Qualitative Research*, *Girlhood Studies*, *Palimpsest*, *SOULS*, and forthcoming in *Women, Gender, and Families of Color* and the *The Black Scholar*. She is the author of *Buy Black: How Black Women Transformed US Pop Culture* (University of Illinois Press, 2022) and editor of *The Black Girlhood Studies Collection* (Women's Press, 2019). She was an Institute for Citizens and Scholars Career Enhancement Fellow (2020-2021), a Donald D. Harrington Faculty Fellow at the University of Texas at Austin (2022-2023), and the 2021 Stuart Hall Foundation x Cultural Studies Award winner for her article "Twerk Sum!: Theorizing Black Girl Epistemology in the Body." She is currently Associate Professor in the Department of Gender and Women's Studies and program in African American and Africana Studies at the University of Kentucky.

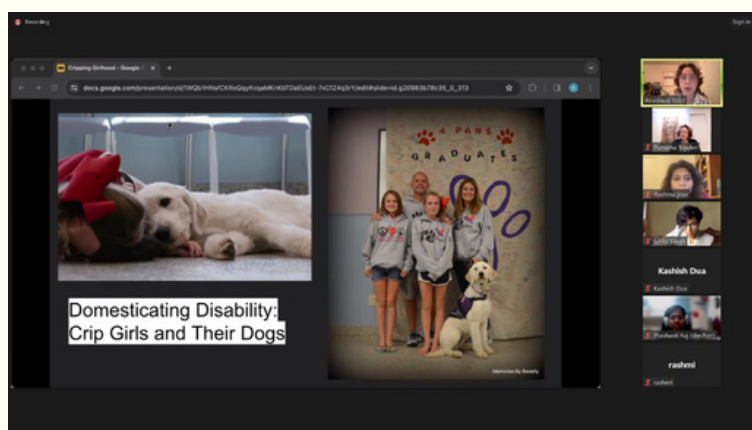
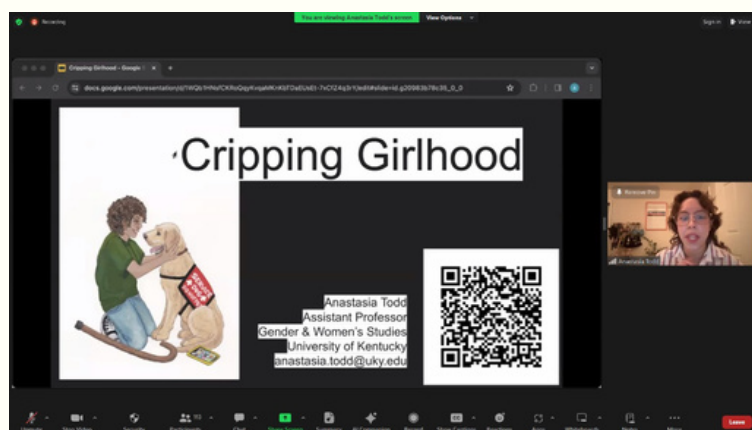
### DR. ANASTASIA TODD

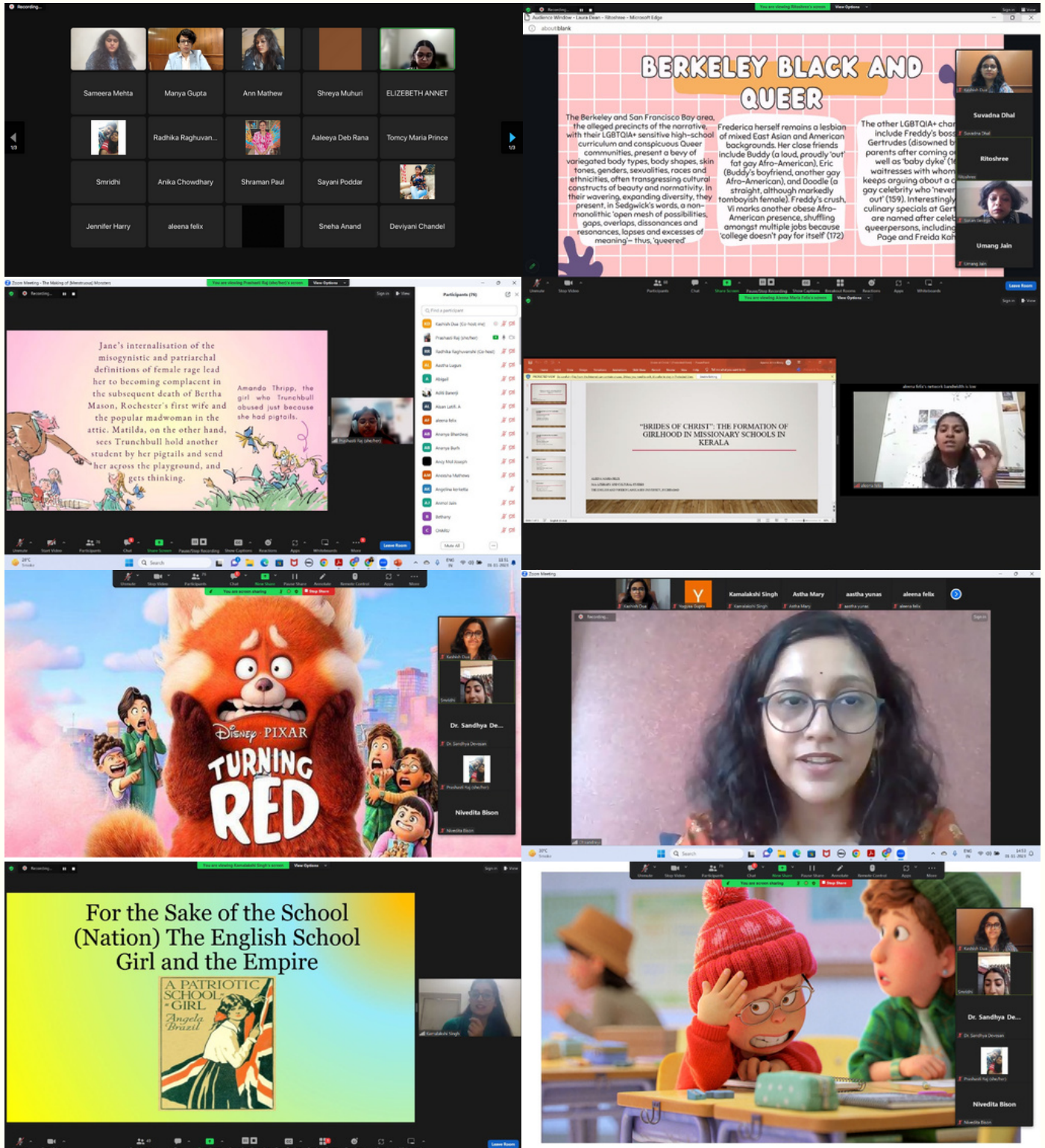
