CONCEPT NOTE

NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR WOMEN

The National Commission for Women was set up as a statutory body in January 1992 under the National Commission for Women Act, 1990 (Act No. 20 of 1990 of Govt. of India). Its objective is to:

- Review the Constitutional and Legal safeguards for women
- Recommend remedial legislative measures

• Facilitate redressal of grievances and advise the government on all policy matters affecting women. In keeping with its mandate, the Commission has initiated various steps to improve the status of women and worked for their economic empowerment. The Commission also conducts visits to all the States/UTs and prepares gender profiles to assess the status of women and helps in empowering them. It acts suo-motu in several cases to provide speedy justice.

GUIDELINES FOR THE PAPER SUBMISSION

There can be more than one author for submitting articles but not more thanfour.

- The submissions are required to be original and unpublished.
- The abstract must not be exceeding 250 words without figures and tables.
- The abstract should be written in MS Word, Times New Roman, single spacingand should include:
- Title (Upper Case, Size 14 points)
- Author(s)'s Name & Affiliation (Size 12 points)
- Abstract (Font Size 12 points): Brief overview of the paper having objective, method and conclusion.
- Keywords: maximum 5 keywords
- The full paper should be approximately 3000 words, 1.5 spacing, Times NewRoman, Font Size 12.
- Title should be in 14-point size.
- The full paper should include Introduction with Objectives, Literature Review, Methodology, Data Analysis & Interpretations/ Findings, Discussions and Conclusion.
- References should be in the API Format.




