- August 14th 2020 – Meeting with Dr. Maya John (Convener) and WSC volunteers to coordinate on the Independence Day Presentation by WSC on 'Women and the Indian National Movement'.
- September 19th 2020 – Introductory Core Team Meeting to get acquainted with the selected Core Team members and suggest ideas for WSC events/online social media campaigns.
- September 27th 2020 – Meeting with Dr. Maya John, the WSC Office Bearers and Research Team Head, to chart out WSC Research Projects and Calendar of events for upcoming months
- October 5th 2020 – Core Team Meeting for the discussion of upcoming collaborations with JMC societies such as Sunny Mugs, the Poetry Society and JMC Education Programme, along with other external organizations such as Advaita and One Future Collective.
