The discussion concluded on a note that appreciation of our mom's work is a must, and one should respect their wishes and desires. Normalizing this ideology in the stereotypical societal norms would be difficult but definitely not a far fetch goal. All volunteers enjoyed the session and gave a positive feedback.






