About the Campaign

The Green Society started an at-Home Plastic Collection Drive in which members, other college students and the general audience were encouraged to replace plastic with other environment-friendly materials.

Students were also asked to segregate and collect plastic over the course of fifteen days. Guidelines were provided to students about how to segregate plastic and what can be used instead.
