


The speaker of the session was, Mr. Sumit Arora, a renowned theatre artist. He guided the participants through the webinar with activities to enhance their skills as writers, actors and orators. The activities included, drawing, writing short stories and poems which talked about expressions and emotions and left everyone with a better sense and understanding of the beautiful art form. The participants were given tasks to write prose or poetry around

Social Media Romanticising Mental Health Issues	25 th September 2020	150	-	<p>Kahkasha, The Dramatics Society in collaboration with <i>You're Wonderful Project</i> conducted an interactive Instagram live on the topic 'Social Media romanticising mental health issues.'</p> <p>We had Ms. Sonakshi Gandhi, a clinical psychologist, as our speaker who shed light on various mental health issues, how they are portrayed in media and their implications on youth. She raised concerns about the importance of seeking help/therapy from a licensed mental health</p>

				<p>professional and provided us with alternatives of different coping mechanisms/methods. Ms. Gandhi made us aware of the importance of identifying the coping mechanisms that work for each person in a unique way for handling anxiety. She emphasized on how popular television series often portray characters with mental illnesses as "quirky" or "cool", which sends out a wrong message of these disorders being "desirable" to the viewers who look up to these characters. The session concluded with a very informative Q&A round, addressing the general queries the audience raised. We are thankful to <i>You're Wonderful Project</i> for this extremely engaging and insightful session, which would definitely help us grow as individuals and as a society.</p>
