6. Attach Minutes of the meetings held during the year

In June 2020 a Creative Writing Competition was held in collaboration with Students for Covid Relief , an initiative started by some students of the University of Delhi to help people that are stranded and are in dire need of support, to make it through these tough times. It received impressive entries from various colleges and universities. On 9 August 2020, Sunny Mugs collaborated with BlueQuill, the

Creative Writing Club of Miranda House for “Pandemic Time Capsule”, an anonymous letter exchange to shine a ray of hope onto strangers. A collection of letters dyed in thousand shades of kindness helped brighten these uncertain times. Hope was found in heartfelt assurances, cute doodles, shared playlists and long lists of recommendations; An anonymous letter exchange to shine a ray of hope onto strangers. As the next segment, the society collaborated with Letters to Strangers, a youth-run global mental health organization, where members sent across letters and received the same from their pen pals. Sunny Mugs, in collaboration with WSC also hosted a webinar on "De-stigmatising Mental Health" by Professor Priya Bhatnagar, followed by an Open Mic. On 27 January 2021, it collaborated with Tape A Tale to organize Stellar 2021, JMC Chapter, an intra-college storytelling competition. In another collaboration, Sunny Mugs came together with Cauldron to host a session on Black Out poetry. The society also collaborated with Panorama for a social media series on cinematic poetry videos. Then came the annual events, Lafzon Ki Numaaish, the annual Hindi-Urdu Slam Poetry Competition and Tailored Verses, the annual English Slam Poetry Competition, held on 28th February 2021 and 7th March 2021 respectively. Both the events witnessed beautiful poetry along with extremely admirable judges. Sunny Mugs also collaborated with Algorithm for a social media series on technology and its forms. An inter-college open mic with Global Youth, JMC Chapter on 10th April 2021 proved to be one of the most celebrated events of the session.

Apart from the collaborative events and slam poetry competitions, Sunny Mugs also held a number of splendid internal open mics and interesting internal sessions, River of Life, Poetry Live Drawing, Kennings, Tips for Performance Poetry, writers’ meme-making, Pick A Poet: Rumi, Feminist Poetry Reading, Inter-relationship between music and poetry. To incite bonding and connect between the society members, two movie screening sessions were organized as well, where ‘Chutney’ and ‘Dead Poets Society’ were respectively screened.
