### GE-DSE SELECTION FOR SEM 2/4/6 (2024-25)

The online portal for students to choose their preferred GENERIC ELECTIVE (GE), GENERIC ELECTIVE LANGUAGES (GE LANG) and/or DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC ELECTIVE (DSE) papers, will be opened **in two phases**:

- i) Phase 1 for Single Discipline (Hons) students, and
- ii) Phase 2 for Multi Discipline (BAP, BCP and B.VOC) students.

Detailed course specific instructions on how to fill up the preference form is available for access within the allocation form in the portal. All students must read these detailed instructions carefully.

All paper allocations are dependent on seat availability. Once the seat capacity of a particular paper is reached, students will not be able to choose that paper. Therefore, all students are advised to exercise their choices at the earliest.

Students must select their papers after due deliberation, and after ensuring that they meet all the eligibility conditions for that paper, if any. No requests for change in papers, once allotted, will be considered by the college.

Classes for GE and DSE will begin from the first day of the new session. Students who do not register their choices through the portal and therefore are not part of any class lists, will lose their attendance till they are able to register their choices when the portal goes live once more for Round 2 of GE, GE Lang and DSE paper allocation.

**All students are therefore advised to register their choices as early as possible within the deadlines applicable to them in Round 1 of GE, GE Lang and DSE paper allocation.**
