All submissions must follow the APA citation stylesheet (7th ed). Article submissions should typically range in length from 6,000–9,000 words (inclusive of all Footnotes and References). Book Reviews should be between 1000–1500 words long. All in-text narrative and parenthetical citations should follow the author-date format. Content footnotes must be used sparingly. All cited works in the submission must be listed alphabetically in the References provided at the end. Submissions complete in all respects and ready for double-blind review should be emailed to jmcreview@jmc.du.ac.in. **Please note *The JMC Review* runs all received manuscripts through a plagiarism checker. Only submissions that pass the software check are forwarded for peer review.**

Your submission should not carry your name or any other identifying information. It should be in MS Word Format (Times New Roman Font, size 12, with 1.5 line spacing and 1-inch margins). Please include your contact information, an abstract between 250–300 words long and a brief bio-note **only in the body of your email**.

The deadline for submissions is 10th July 2026. Our review process usually takes 3 months, so if authors submit their article in early May, they should hear back from us by the end of August 2026, at the latest. We encourage early submissions.
