Day 2 Report (20 January 2026)

The Department of **B. Voc. Healthcare Management**, Jesus and Mary College, successfully conducted the **second day of Career Odyssey 2.0** on **20 January 2026**. The focus of Day 2 was on **personal interviews, professional presence, grooming, and career readiness**, aimed specifically at preparing students for real-world placement processes.

It is important to note that **this phase of the event was exclusively conducted for second-year and third-year students** of the B. Voc. Healthcare Management course. **First-year students were not part of the Day 2 activities**, as the sessions required students to present resumes and participate in mock interview rounds.

Session Coordination and Hosts

The event proceedings were smoothly conducted by the student hosts **Pravidhi** and **Lovelin**, who ensured a structured flow of the sessions and maintained discipline and engagement throughout the day.

The speakers were formally introduced by: **Mr. Tanmay Arora, CA Sumit Chincholikar and Ms. Siya Anand**

Session by Mr. Tanmay Arora

Mr. **Tanmay Arora** delivered an insightful and engaging session titled “**From Invisible to Irresistible.**” The session primarily focused on **building self-confidence, personal branding, and improving interview presence.**

He shared practical techniques to enhance self-awareness, including:

- Recording oneself while delivering a self-introduction
- Reviewing the video without audio to assess **body language, posture, and expressions**
- Listening to the audio separately to analyse **tone, clarity, and pitch of voice**

Mr. Arora conducted a detailed discussion on **presence in interviews**, highlighting the importance of:

- Voice modulation, tone, and pitch
- Structuring answers meaningfully
- Asking relevant questions
- Showing respect and attentiveness towards the interviewer

Based on the content displayed during the session, Mr. Arora also shared **advanced LinkedIn job-search strategies**, including:

- Viewing **ultra-fresh job postings** by modifying LinkedIn job search filters to access opportunities posted within the **last hour**, giving candidates a competitive advantage
- Using LinkedIn’s “**Posts**” tab instead of the “**Jobs**” tab to discover **hidden or unlisted job opportunities**
- Searching phrases such as “*we’re hiring*” along with role-specific keywords to identify informal hiring posts
- Sorting posts by “**Latest**” and reaching out proactively through **direct messages or personalized comments**
- Applying early to be among the **first 10–20 applicants**, significantly improving visibility

He also guided students on **articulating ideas clearly and effectively**, ensuring alignment between verbal communication and non-verbal cues. The session concluded with an interactive **doubt-clearing segment**, where students raised questions related to interviews, LinkedIn usage, and professional communication.

Session by CA Sumit Chincholikar

CA **Sumit Chincholikar** began his interaction by showing a video emphasizing that while **starting and ending tasks may appear easy, long-term consistency and maintenance are the real challenges** in professional life.

He shared his **personal interview and corporate experiences**, giving students a realistic understanding of employer expectations, decision-making processes and professional accountability. He also clearly explained what he was **looking for during the mock interview rounds**, such as honesty and clarity in answers, logical thinking, willingness to learn professional conduct and confidence

This session helped students understand interviews from the **interviewer's perspective**, making the experience more insightful and practical.

Workshop by Ms. Siya Anand

Ms. **Siya Anand** conducted a highly interactive workshop on **professional appearance, interview attire, and workplace etiquette**. The session included **live demonstrations with student volunteers**, enhancing practical understanding. She spoke on interview-appropriate behaviour, body language and posture and the importance of **power dressing**. Ms. Anand introduced the **4As of Professional Appearance: Appropriate dressing, Attractive presentation, Authenticity, Accountability**

Her session highlighted how grooming and presentation play a crucial role in creating a positive first impression.

Mock Interview Round

One-on-one **mock interviews** were conducted by: **Mr. Tanmay Arora, CA Sumit Chincholikar and Ms. Siya Anand**

Students were asked **resume-based and role-specific questions**. The panelists provided **real-time corrective feedback**, suggesting more effective answer framing, better communication techniques and Improved professional conduct. A collective feedback

session followed, where the panelists shared constructive observations and actionable suggestions for improvement.

The event concluded with a **vote of thanks delivered by the Vice President**, followed by a **photo session**, marking the successful completion of **Day 2 of Career Odyssey 2.0**.

Conclusion

Day 2 of Career Odyssey 2.0 proved to be highly impactful for **second- and third-year B. Voc. Healthcare Management students**, equipping them with practical interview skills, professional grooming insights, and real-world career strategies.
