## **General Instructions for Students**

- 1. The deadline for submitting the form is Sunday, 4th January 2026, 5.00 p.m.
- 2. A student can SUBMIT the form **ONLY ONCE**.
- 3. Please make your choices after careful consideration. Requests for change of papers WILL NOT BE entertained later.
- 4. Students will be allotted courses on **first-come-first-serve** basis. Once the seat capacity of a particular course is filled, the students will not be able to choose that paper.
- 5. The course allocations will be notified on the college website by 5th January 2026 and the students are requested to check the college website for the same. No individual e-mails will be sent out to the students notifying them about their course allocation.

## **AEC Modern Indian Languages Paper Instructions**

- 1. Students can opt Hindi A only of they have studied Hindi in class XII.
- 2. Students can opt Hindi B only if they have studied Hindi in class X.
- 3. Students can opt Hindi C only if they have studied Hindi in class VIII.
- 4. Hindi D is for foreign students.
- 5. Hindi E is for Indian students who have not studied Hindi in class VIII.
- 6. Jesus and Mary College offers Hindi Language A, B and C only.
- 7. The classes of AEC Indian languages other than Hindi will be held in South Cluster colleges (outside JMC).

## **VAC Paper Instructions for Students**

- 1. All students of Semester II and IV should study ONE Value Addition Course (VAC) and ONE Ability Enhancement Course (AEC).
- 2. Only Semester II students have to fill AEC option. All Hons students will be studying EVS. Only BA (MD), B.VOC and B.Com students have to select any one MIL out of the 22 languages available. In Semester IV, all Hons students will be studying MIL and Ba(Md), B.Voc and B.Com will be studying EVS.
- 3. Students CAN choose a VAC paper being offered by their parent department provided that the syllabus is not similar to the DSC/DSE/GE/VAC/SEC courses that they are studying, or are expected to study. Please read the pre-requisite information carefully.
- 4. There are 14 Value Addition Courses in Semester II and 12 Value Addition Courses in Semester IV and 22 Ability Enhancement Courses offered by Jesus and Mary College in the upcoming session (Courses offered by Jesus and Mary College are clearly indicated in the portal). However, students are free to choose from entire list of 33 VACs notified by the University of Delhi (which may be offered by other colleges in the South Cluster). Please note that a student cannot choose a VAC paper that they have already opted in an earlier semester, even if the same paper is being offered by a different Department in the upcoming semester.
- 5. Allocation of seats for the students who choose **courses in the cluster colleges** will be done subject to seat availability in South Campus Colleges offering those specific VAC courses.

- 6. If your first preference for VAC is a course offered by a Cluster College, it is mandatory to choose courses in JMC as your second and third preferences.
- 7. It is advised you go through the syllabus of papers on the DU Website (<u>VAC Link</u>, <u>AEC Link</u>) also to ensure that you satisfy the minimum eligibility conditions for the papers, if any.
- 8. To avoid technical glitches, please ensure that you have access to a proper internet connection. Also, it is advisable to take **screenshots of your submission** (with the time, your name and roll number clearly visible) once the preferences are filled in the form. You can submit the form for VAC and AEC only once.
