Guidelines (for Abstract)

- 1) The **abstract title** should be precise, clear and engaging.
- 2) Provide the author name(s), present affiliation, email address, and ORCID ID.
- 3) The abstract should include the background of the study, materials and methodology, key findings, and conclusions.
- 4) The abstract must not exceed **350 words**.
- 5) Provide up to **five (05) carefully chosen keywords** that best represent your study. Avoid repeating words already used in the title.
- 6) Submit your abstract in **Microsoft Word** (.doc/.docx) format only.

Guidelines (for Full-length Manuscript)

Each manuscript may be approximately **6,500-7,500 words (including references)** in length in **Microsoft Word** (.doc/.docx) format only and must include the following sections:

Manuscript Title

- **Author name(s)**, present affiliation(s), email address(es), and ORCID iD(s)
- **Abstract** (maximum 200 words)
- **Keywords** (maximum 5)
- **Introduction**
- **Study Area**
- **Materials and Methods**
- **Results and Discussion**
- **Sustainability Perspective / Sustainable Solutions with Findings**
- **Conclusions**
- **Additional Section(s) (Optional):** Rationale of the Study; Need for the Study; Limitations/Challenges of the Study; Recommendations; or other relevant aspects
- **Acknowledgments** (if any)
- **Author Contributions** (if any)
- **Declarations** (Conflict of Interest and AI Disclosure) ▪ **References** (APA style only)

- 2) Please provide a brief **biography for each author** (maximum 100 words).

- 3) All candidates must ensure that their manuscripts undergo mandatory plagiarism checks and comply with the prescribed originality standards before submission. All submissions will

undergo mandatory plagiarism screening using approved plagiarism detection software, and manuscripts found to contain unacceptable levels of similarity will be rejected or returned for revision. Please attach **Turnitin software report** along with your full manuscript submission.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation

Please ensure your poster meets the criteria below.

- 1) The dimensions of the poster should not exceed **90cm wide x 120cm high**.
- 2) The text on the poster should be legible from about 4 feet away.
- 3) Content and lay out of the poster:
 - The title, names of authors and affiliation (s) as stated on the submitted abstract should be included at the top of the poster.
 - Poster layout should be in a logical order, including text and graphics that explain the objectives of the research and importance of research; hypothesis/statement of the problem; methodology; results; conclusions and future outcome of research; references and acknowledgements.
 - The pictures, illustrations, etc. should be clear enough to be read from a distance.
- 4) Participants are advised to bring materials like cello-tape, double-sided tape, board pins etc. however; technical equipment will be available for the mounting of posters.
- 5) Please note that you are required to print your poster in advance, as printing provision is not kept at the venue.

Presenters are encouraged to stand by their posters during the breaks for informal discussions or to answer questions.
