Important Dates:

5th September – 8th September 2022: Nominations invited for the posts of President and Vice President.

9th September – 11th September 2022: Withdrawal of nominations to be intimated via email to convenor.studentcouncil@jmc.ac.in latest by **11th September 8pm**.

12th September 2022: Scrutiny of nominations and important instructions to be issued to candidates in a meeting in college. **Time and Place shall be notified to prospective candidates.**

13th September – 16th September 2022: Campaigning by prospective candidates.

16th September 2022: Presidential and Vice-Presidential Debate in college. **Time and Place shall be notified.**

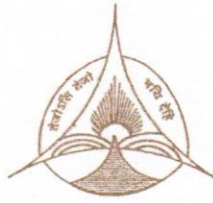
17th September 2022: Canvassing closed from **8pm** onwards.

19th September 2022: Students' Council Elections from **10am – 2pm**. Google Form link for voting shall be shared on **19th September (Morning)**.

Nomination Guidelines

1. Open to all bonafide students of 2nd, 3rd and 4th Year (B. El. Ed Department) of the college.
2. Nominations to be filed between **5th September 2022 (10:00am) to 8th September 2022 (4:00pm)**.
3. Nomination forms will be available with Ms. Lincy, PA to the Principal, from **5th September to 8th September 2022**.
4. The Presidential candidate should be proposed and seconded only by third-year students.
5. The Vice-Presidential candidate should be proposed and seconded only by second-year students.
6. Proposer / Seconder can propose / second only one candidate for either of the two posts.
7. Duly filled nomination forms should be submitted to **Ms. Lincy by 8th September 2022 (4:00pm)** along with a copy of the college ID card of the candidate, proposer and seconder.
8. All candidates must be present along with their college ID cards for the meeting with the Students' Council Faculty Advisors on **12th September 2022**. Time and place shall be notified to prospective candidates.
9. If any candidate fails to clear their previous semester examinations upon the declaration of result, their candidature shall stand disqualified.
10. Once the President and Vice President have been elected, they cannot hold any other post at the department or society level.
