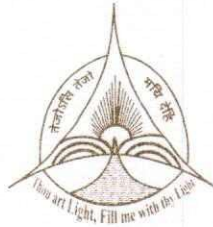

16th – 17th April 2026: Withdrawal of nominations to be intimated via email to convenor.studentcouncil@jmc.ac.in latest by **17th April, 2026 5:00 PM.**

20th April 2026: Scrutiny of nominations and important instructions to be issued to candidates in an online meeting.

21st – 22nd April 2026: Campaigning by prospective candidates

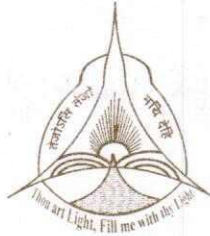
23th April 2026: Presidential and Vice-Presidential Debate in College. **Time and Place shall be notified.**

23 April 2026: Canvassing closed from **8 pm** onwards

24th April 2026: Students' Council Elections from **10am - 2pm.** Form Link shall be shared on **24th April 2026 (Morning).**

Nomination Guidelines

1. Open to all bonafide students in the 1st and 2nd years of the college, as well as 3rd-year students from the B.El.Ed. department.
2. Nomination to be filled between **13th April (10:00 am) to 16th April 2026 (1:00 pm)**.
3. Nomination forms will be available with Ms. Cherry, PA to the Principal, from **13th April to 16th April 2026**.
4. The Presidential candidate should be proposed and seconded only by the forthcoming third-year students.
5. The Vice-Presidential candidate should be proposed and seconded only by the forthcoming second-year students
6. Proposer / Seconder can propose / second only one candidate for either of the two posts.
7. Duly filled nomination forms should be submitted to **Ms. Cherry by 16th April 2026 (1:00 pm)** along with a copy of the college ID card of the candidate, proposer and seconder, and the candidate's previous semester marksheet.
8. All candidates must be present along with their college ID cards for the meeting with the Students' Council Faculty Advisors on **20th April 2026**. Time and Gmeet link shall be notified.
9. If any candidate fails to clear their previous and forthcoming semester examinations upon the declaration of the result, their candidature shall stand disqualified.
10. All candidates must have an aggregate of attendance of 70% or above.
11. All candidates are required to also provide names of three faculty members who may be contacted as referees. These faculty members should know the candidate's academic or extra-curricular (society/departmental level) contributions to college.
12. Once the President and Vice President have been elected, they cannot hold any other post at the department or society level.
13. The Students' Council reserves the right to revoke any candidature at any point without prior notice.
