In this workshop we will sharpen a few skills that all academic writers constantly utilise. We will work on the ability to say in our words what we read in the work of others (summary); and then the skill to have something to say about it (analysis). When we use the work of others, either in our words (summary) or in their own (quotation), we have to attribute ideas carefully and correctly. This is the work of citation. The sharpest skill of all is to know how to indicate in our analysis which ideas come from others and what of our own we have built with it (argument).
