Anita Mannur is professor of English at Miami University, USA. She is author of Intimate Eating: Racialized Spaces, Radical Futures (Duke UP 2022) and Culinary Fictions: Food in South Asian Diasporic Culture (Temple UP 2010).



PROF. DORIS WITT

Doris Witt is a professor in the English department at the University of Iowa, where she teaches classes in 20th-21st century American and transnational and postcolonial literature. Her current food-themed project, The Culinary Catch-22, is a cultural study of American food writing during the neoliberal era.



PROF. PARAMA ROY

Parama Roy is Professor Emerita of English at the University of California, Davis.
