About the Seminar

The Department of Psychology, Jesus and Mary College, University of Delhi, invites you to our upcoming National Seminar on the theme 'The Unconscious Communication in Psychoanalysis' on 22 January 2020. The seminar is an initiative to provide an avenue for bringing together some experts from the Psychoanalytic community under one roof to discuss subtle nuances of therapy.

The ultimate reality of the subjective world of the patient is unknown. It is against this impossibility that the psychoanalyst attempts to make sense of the patients' subjective or internal state of mind. Human beings send and receive messages/ communications. The challenge is to decode the encoded meaning. In this context, unconscious communication and work on it is significant to access the affect of the patient especially when the patient is unable to communicate the internal experience in words. The unsymbolized experience gets enacted in the transference as the unconscious communication. This phemomena deserves closer investigation especially with a view to finding out whether preconscious activity can be excluded as playing a part in it, but descriptively speaking, the fact is incontestable. To understand the internal world of the patient, the psychoanalyst listens outside (to other) for the intricate cues and clues given out by the patients' unconscious. Simultaneously, he listens inside (to self) for reflexivity (awareness of self in action), memory evoked, emotional sensations or reactions, physiological sensations or reactions, fantasies.

The seminar will commence with a keynote address by *Prof. Ashok Nagpal* (Former Dean, School of Human Studies, Ambedkar University, Delhi) after which, there will be a panel discussion led by *Ms. Nuzhat Khan* (Supervising Psychoanalyst) and *Dr. Nilofer Kaul* (Supervising Psychoanalyst). This will be followed by an interactive session with *Dr. Amrita Narayanan* (Psychoanalyst), *Ms. Neetu Sarin* (Assistant Professor & Psychoanalytic Therapist at the School of Human Studies, Ambedkar University, Delhi) and *Dr. Ashis Roy* (Psychoanalytic Therapist, Faculty and Researcher, School of Human Studies, Ambedkar University, Delhi). Thereafter, there will be paper presentations by scholars and practioners on the following sub themes:

- Use of Reverie
- Use of Fantasy
- Bodily Experiences as a Channel
- Role of Transference and Counter-transference
- Role of the Therapist's Dreams about the Patient

It is our belief that the seminar will equip the delegates by providing a window into the field of psychoanalysis, where the participants will gain an insight into the workings of a therapy session.
