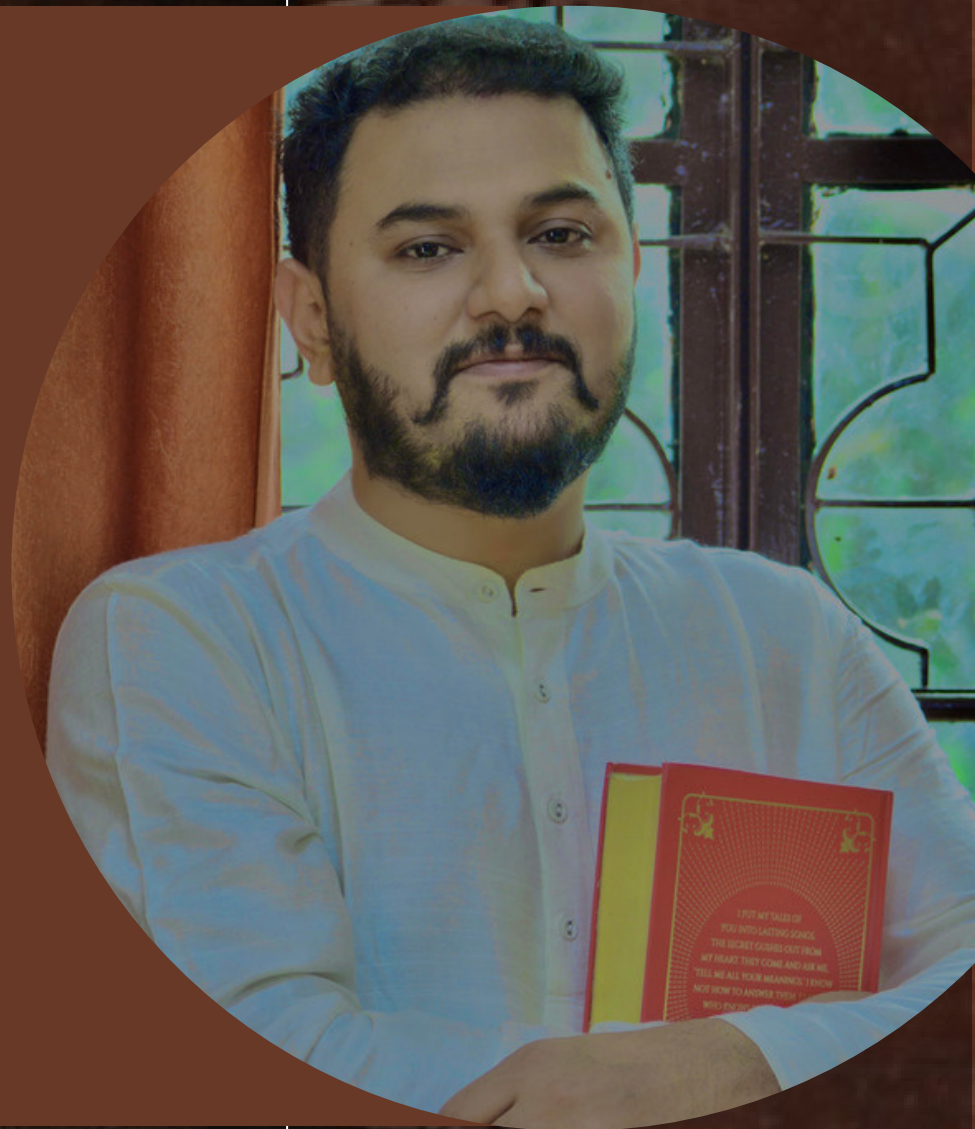

Sonnet Mondal

Sonnet Mondal writes from Kolkata and is the author of *Karmic Chanting* (Copper Coin, 2018), *Ink and Line* (Dhaulti Books, 2018) and five other books of poetry. He has read at literary festivals in Macedonia, Ireland, Turkey, Nicaragua, Sri Lanka, Germany, Italy, Ukraine, Hungary and Slovakia. His writings have appeared in publications across Europe, North America, Asia, Africa and Australia. He has served as a guest editor for Poetry at Sangam and Words Without Borders.

Founder and director of Chair Poetry Evenings: Kolkata's International Poetry Festival, Mondal edits the Indian section of Lyrikline (Haus für Poesie, Berlin) and serves as managing editor of Verseville. His works have been translated into over fifteen languages.



Sarabjeet Garcha

Sarabjeet Garcha is the author of four books of poems—including *A Clock in the Far Past*—besides a volume each of translated poetry and translated prose. He has translated several American poets into Hindi, including W.S. Merwin and John Haines, and several Indian poets into English, among them Mangalesh Dabral and Leeladhar Jagoori. His poems, translations, and essays have been widely published. He received the Fellowship for Outstanding Artists (2013-14) from the Government of India and the International Publishing Fellowship (2022) from the British Council. His poems have been translated into German, Spanish, Russian, Malayalam, Kannada, Marathi, Punjabi and Hindi.
