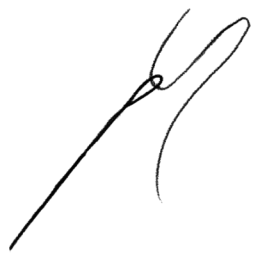


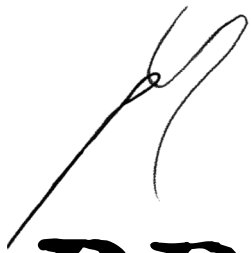
# PROMPT I

-Lidia Yuknavitch, *The Chronology of Water*






# PROMPT 3

- Sylvia Plath



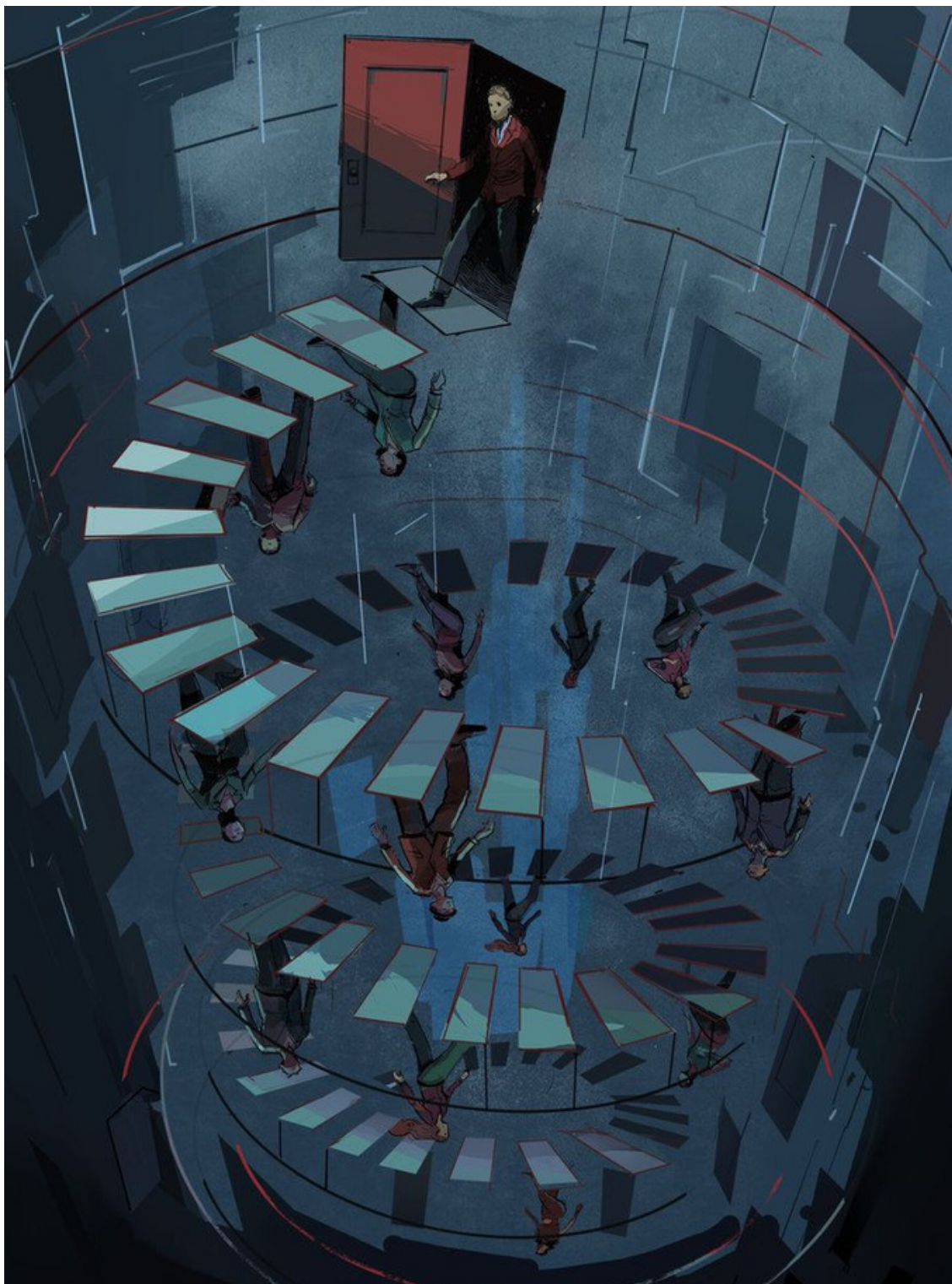


# PROMPT 4

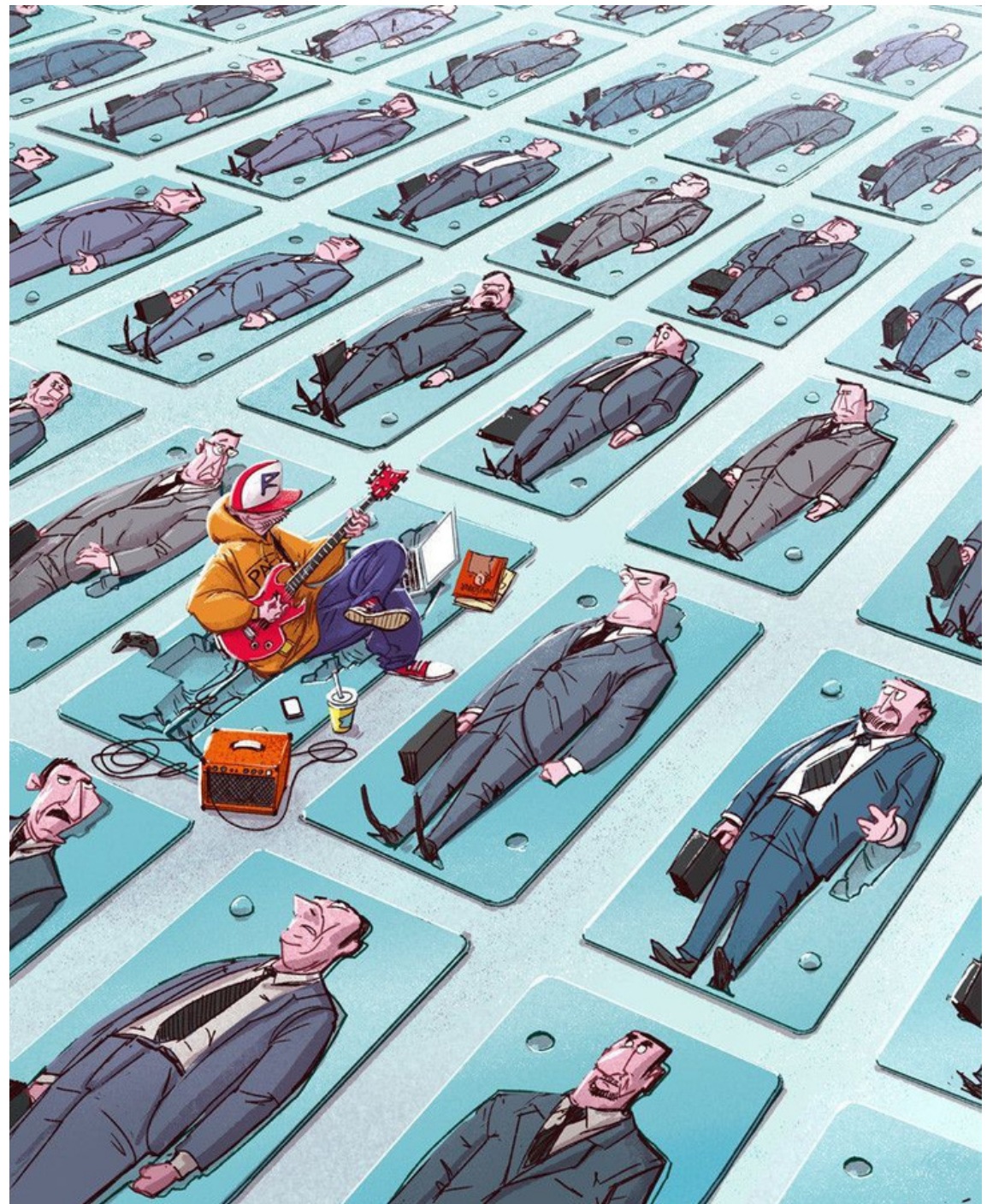
