About the speaker:

Shri Anil Swarup, IAS, has worked in the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Coal and the Ministry of Employment & Labour. He's a former Secretary, Education, HRD, Government of India. In his capacity as Secretary, Ministry of Coal, he was instrumental in carrying out the auction of coal blocks that is likely to result in a revenue flow of around Rs. 3 Lakh Crore to the States. The initiatives taken by him resulted in record production of coal in the country. This production helped in tiding over the crisis created by coal shortages. His past assignments in various Ministries of the Government reflect his in-depth knowledge and experience in visualising, conceptualising, articulating and implementing various schemes. At the very beginning of his administrative career he was awarded the Best officer Award at Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration amongst the officers of 1981 batch. As a strategic thinker and an innovative leader he has won several awards and nominations, the prominent ones being: Nominated as one of the "policy change agent" by The Economics Times during the years 2010, 2012, 2015 & 2016. He was selected as one of the 35 "Action Heroes" in India Today's 35th Annual Edition.




Relevance of the webinar to respondents (on a scale of 1 to 5):


