ADMISSIONS 2022-2023

The admission procedure for all undergraduate candidates (women only) to Jesus and Mary College is as follows:

Jesus and Mary College will admit the candidates on the basis of the eligibility criteria published by the University of Delhi in its Bulletin of Information 2022 and the rules laid in the Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS) 2022. The applicant should have registered on the CSAS 2022 admission portal of the University of Delhi.

1. ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR UNRESERVED CATEGORY CANDIDATES

(i) 50% of the total seats for each programme are for **unreserved category** that will be allocated through the CSAS portal of Delhi University.

2. ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR RESERVED (MINORITY CHRISTIAN) CATEGORY CANDIDATES

- (i) 50% of the total number of seats are for women candidates belonging to the Christian minority category.
- (ii) Merit would be decided on the basis of a weightage of 85% of the CUET programme specific score and 15% for an interview that will be held by the College.
- (iii) The Board to interview Christian candidates shall include one Christian member of the Governing Body nominated by the Chairperson of the Governing Body.
- (iv) All minority (Christian) women candidates who opted for JMC in the UoD Admission portal are eligible to appear in the interview conducted by the College.
- (v) All Christian candidates will have to submit a copy of the Baptism Certificate (valid from at least two years prior to the last date fixed for receipt of applications) and a letter of recommendation from the Parish Priest of their respective Diocese.
- (vi) Non-Catholic candidates who have not undergone Baptism (being members of Churches that practice adult or believers' Baptism) may submit the Baptism Certificate of either of their parents and a certificate from the priest/pastor concerned stating that the candidate is a practising Christian.
- (vii) Christian candidates are required to keep checking the website for further information. The date of interviews for Christian candidates will be announced on the website of the College www.jmc.ac.in
- (viii) In all matters the Principal's decision will be final.
