Action Taken Report 2021 - 2022

- AQAR 2020-21 was submitted to NAAC within the stipulated timeline.
- The College geared up for the Peer Team visit during Nov 2021 keeping all Covid related Protocols in place. A Mock Visit was also organised to acquaint the stakeholders about the conduct of the visit.
- The Peer Team visit was completed successfully and the College was Accredited with A+ grade, with a CGPA of 3.35.
- The College is working proactively towards developing skill and entrepreneurial attributes amongst its students. An MoU was signed with SkillLabs, a consultancy firm which aims at setting up Financial Lab and business incubation Centre for providing the requisite knowledge, skills and abilities to our students.
- Individual interactive sessions were held to help the administrative staff to cope with the challenges posed by the pandemic and thereafter.
- The IQAC organised six talks, Seminars, special lectures on aspects related to quality enhancement in higher education, research, publications, plagiarism etc. The different departments of the College also organised activities and events to keep the faculty and students abreast with the advances in their respective disciplines.
- Academic Administrative Audits were also organised by the IQAC along with External Experts and academicians.
- A robust Web-based portal has been developed for capturing, analysing and reporting data from Students, Faculty, Departments and Societies. This has streamlined the process of data gathering for all stakeholders and statutory processes of the institution.
- The College has recognized the academic contributions of its faculty towards teaching and research, the process of promotions of six faculty members to the post of Professor, two faculty members to the post Associate Professor and 36 Assistant Professors from Stage 10 to Stage 11 or Stage 11 to Stage 12. This is a major step taken towards the career advancement of the faculty members.
- The Library Committee has been constituted with the aim to enhance the library resources and also to inculcate a culture of reading, writing and research amongst faculty and students alike.
- Webinars were organised by the various departments in the Online as well as offline mode. An International Conference was also organised by the Department of Commerce.
- A Comprehensive survey of flora and fauna on the Campus was conducted and all the
 different varieties of trees were identified and marked. A scientific method was adopted
 to undertake this activity with professional assistance.
