18. SWOC Analysis

Biggest strength of the Department: provision of interdisciplinary opportunities to students from different streams and diverse interests through the cells of the department. Research Cell (Ecognition): Its purpose: providing students with field experience and opportunities to publish in renowned journals and books. Department encourages students to collaborate with faculty and alumnae for research. Students of the Department have interned with faculty members on government sponsored projects. Dynamic faculty which has ensured that the students have exposure to a myriad of curricular, co-curricular (including research) and extra-curricular events. They have been actively engaged in keeping their skills up to date by attending regular faculty development programs Senior Faculty Members in the department have been involved in various administrative activities of the college: Ms.Smita Gupta - IQAC Member & Convenor of Green Society, Ms. Shalini Srivastava- TIC & Convenor of the Website Committee, Ms. Rajni Singh- Convenor of JMCEP & Dr. Daisy Sales- Bursar of the college. Strong link between the Department and alumni exists: engaging with current students by delivering talks and providing details of job and internship opportunities. The number of publications in Scopus indexed journals, UGC journals and peer-reviewed journals have been relatively low. Constraints in availability of computer labs to teach software oriented courses. Opportunities Online paradigm: made it easier to get academicians from across the globe to engage with students through webinars. Research collaborations with foreign universities: easier now in the online mode. Greater opportunity for students under the multidisciplinary paradigm for intersectional learning. Challenges Difficulty in balancing time between co-curricular activities and extracurricular activities, with overlapping semesters. Databases and statistical software's can be made available to offer papers specified under the UGCF framework and for research as well.

19. Future Plans

The Department plans to conduct a National/International Conference in 2024-25. Under the Research Cell (Ecognition), the Department plans to conduct a post-covid assessment survey in Sanjay Camp. There is scope to increase Faculty Research Publications in Scopus and UGC-Care Listed Journals and undertake more funded research projects. The Department aims to increase its social and community outreach by forming long term relationship with a social organisation (Blind school, Orphanage and Care home for terminally ill people) As a part of its initiatives towards environment conservation, the Department will work closely with the Green Society of the College. Banning the use of single use plastic, for instance. Under the prospective collaboration of Jesus and Mary College with Liverpool Hope University, the Department will encourage its faculty and students to join the exchange program.
