They have been actively engaged in keeping their skills up to date by attending regular faculty development programs. While the junior faculty members are leading in research and other administrative, research and teaching activities inside and outside the college, the senior faculty Members in the department have been involved in various administrative activities of the college as well. We also have a strong link between the Department and alumni exists: engaging with current students by delivering talks and providing details of job and internship opportunities. This provides greater opportunity for students under the multidisciplinary paradigm for intersectional learning. Challenges: We face difficulty in balancing time between co-curricular activities and extracurricular activities, with overlapping semesters. Databases and statistical softwares can be made available to offer papers specified under the UGCF framework and for research as well.

19. Future Plans

The Department plans to conduct a National/International Conference in 2025-26. We aim to increase Faculty Research Publications in highly cited Scopus indexed Journals and books, and undertake more funded research projects. We aim more of Faculty-Student research collaborations for publication in indexed journals. The Department aims to increase its social and community outreach by forming long term relationship with a social organisation (Blind school, Orphanage and Care home for terminally ill people). We aim for more MOUs with companies, research institutions and government organisations, to place students with better internship opportunities.
