18. SWOC Analysis

Strengths: 1) The department has experienced subject experts who are equipped to teach different periods of Indian as well as world history. This allows the department to effectively foster in its students a sound grasp over different aspects of history, nurture required training in historical methods and a familiarity with interdisciplinary perspectives. 2) Another strength of the Department is the continuous effort made to involve students in co-curricular & extra-curricular activities. In this regard, the Department has been organising field trips, museum visits, heritage walks, seminars and talks by reputed international and Indian scholars, as well as involving several of its students in oral history projects wherein the students are being gradually introduced to the skill of conducting interviews and archiving them from the perspective of generating primary source material for documenting oral histories. 3) The Department's strength also includes consistent efforts to introduce students to histories beyond the syllabi, such as of lesser known regions & histories of marginalities. For this, its annual student seminar, invited lectures & the student journal, Maazinama, which is now in its fourth year, prove useful. 4) The Department was able to organize for some of its second and third year Hons and Program students quality internships with organizations like India CityWalks, Itihasology, NDD News, LeadIAS, etc. Weakness: 1) A weakness is the lack of adequate ICT & funding for ongoing projects. 2) Delay in attaining approval for the M.A. History course in JMC. 3) The department has not had an opportunity to host a national or international conference in 2024-25.

19. Future Plans

1) We intend to organise an international seminar/conference. 2) We plan to see through the introduction of the M.A History program. 3) The Department seeks to further standardize and enlarge the contents of the the annual student journal, Maazinama. 4) With the introduction of the fourth year in the UG program, we also have plans to start a Book Club or regular student-led colloquiums that would provide the support structure for informal discussions around the students' developing UG research, important historical scholarship, and newer work being published.
