18. SWOC Analysis

The department has been able to provide good mentorship to its students both in the sphere of curricular and extra-curricular activities. Our students guided by teacher mentors were able to secure awards and selection in competitive paper presentations and journals respectively. We have been able to continue with our department academic talks, tours, heritage walks, workshops, student paper submissions despite the challenges of having parallel semesters. All the teachers of the department have been providing offline lectures and guidance through both online and offline learning resources. Our teachers and students have also published in journals, engaged in paper presentations etc. Some of our faculty have got prestigious grants for doing their research work and have been called as resource persons or as participants of short term courses. The department has also continued with its collection drives -clothing, food etc that have been distributed to the needy. Our students have wholeheartedly helped and participated in the organization committees for orientation day, PTSA, NSS and other college activities. They have participated across the year in various inter and intra departmental activities and competitions outside our college to bring laurels to us. Though the master's in history programme was envisioned we have not been yet able to launch it as the university has not deliberated upon our submissions in its AC/EC meeting. In this regard the department members would soon be following up the status of the submitted file and work towards initiating the master's in history at Jesus and Mary college.

19. Future Plans

The teachers have been consistent in their efforts of devising innovative methods in both teaching& learning and assessment process to provide quality education to our students. We have successfully launched our Oral History Archive last year with the launch of our department undergraduate journal called 'Maazinama'. We are in due process to bring out our second volume of 'Maazinama' by February 2023. We will also be holding a student paper presentation in the coming month of February to provide undergraduate students a platform to showcase their research skills. We also plan to have an oral history collaboration with other universities and research organizations so that our students can be trained in the methodology and make their contribution to society via original data collection.
