- > Dealing with students' issues pertaining to accessibility to technology and ICT skills (especially since shift to e-learning).
- ➤ Challenges associated with shift to virtual teaching adapting to changing pedagogy.

### 20. Future Plans

- > Considering the ongoing pandemic, the department hopes to focus on assisting the students in meaningful ways in the upcoming semester. The focus would not just be on academic growth, but on their holistic development and creating a safe community for the students so that they find themselves better equipped to handle the challenges posed by the current situation.
- > Focus on better networking with the alumni.
- > Keeping in mind numerous activities (within and outside the department), the department would like to offer a suggestion that alternate weeks be delineated for society and association activities so that the students do not miss out on any opportunities.

- A meeting was organized on the Zoom platform to discuss the modalities of the Internal Assessment (IA), Practical, Viva-Voce and Projects for the year 2019-20 (Sem: Jan April), in light of a letter (dated **13.05.2020**) received from the University (Dean, Examinations) regarding the same.
- A point-by-point discussion was held among the department members, covering the contents of the letter. Following careful deliberations, the following decisions were taken:

- It was decided that the students' practical reports would be considered as an appropriate submission and they shall share them with their respective teachers with the following details i.e., the name of the student, the name of program, Semester, & title of practical paper.
- It was also agreed upon that a schedule would be shared with the students for each practical paper, in accordance with which they would be required to make their submissions. As per the dates given, a window of a few hours will be decided in advance to ensure timely submission of the practical reports.
- Furthermore, Dr. Ameeta Parsuram pointed that a proper record of the same can be maintained by downloading all the reports and arranging them in a folder/pen-drive.
- It was also decided that teachers for particular practical papers can first mark each student out of 50 i.e., 25 marks for the report and 25 marks as per their continuous evaluation over the course of the semester. After doing so, marks of the teachers taking the same practical paper would be averaged to yield the students' final score.
- Finally, the teachers will keep the marks ready by 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 so that they can be uploaded/submitted as per the instructions that would be provided by the Principal/University.
- Importantly, Ms. Annie Baxi raised a concern about past year students attempting for their repeat practical exam. Consistent with the above mentioned decisions, it was finalized that they would be marked based on their report and past year performance. The teacher who had taught them the same paper last year can help in ascertaining their continuous evaluation.

### **Evaluation of Dissertations**

- Regarding the evaluation of the third year students' dissertation, a consensus was reached that their assessment would be divided in two sections. Out of 150 marks, 100 marks would be based on their dissertation report (prepared in accordance with the university guidelines for report formation) and a smaller assignment would be taken to account for the remaining 50 marks (in lieu of viva-voce).
- Dr. Parsuram suggested that this assignment could include an overview of the research method and findings, plus students could also reflect on their learnings during the same. Agreement from other members was received on the same.

•	Therefore, the teachers supervising the dissertations would be devising a format for this assignment to be shared with the students and a deadlin would be set accordingly for both submissions.	ıe

- A meeting was organized on the Zoom platform on 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 (at 3 pm) to finalise the guidelines about the project submission of the third year students with Dissertations.
- It was decided that the final project report (accounting for 100 marks) shall be submitted to the project supervisor on 24<sup>th</sup> May 2020, at a predetermined time.
- A discussion was also held about the requirements of the assignment (for 50 marks) to be given to the students, in lieu of viva-voce.
- It was decided that the teachers supervising the dissertation would be devising one common question that would be shared with the students at a predetermined date & time. The students would be given a duration of three hours to send (via e-mail) their assignment.
- Regarding the contents of the assignment, it was decided that the students would be asked to provide an overview of their research covering the following: the introduction, method, major findings as well as the relevance/implications of their research, complete with references in the APA format. They would also be asked to write about their subjective experience of conducting the research.
- The exact question to be sent to the students will be worked out soon by all the project teachers.
- With reference to the decision taken yesterday about making a schedule for the submission of practical reports, Ms. Isha Mishra and Ms. Sudha Shashwati would prepare the schedule for all hons. Practical papers, while Dr. Priya Bhatnagar is doing the same for students of B.A. Program.

A departmental meeting was held on 1st July 2020, between 9:30 a.m. to 10.50 a.m. via Google Meet. The following topics were discussed:

# **Workload for the Semester (July – December, 2020)**

→ To begin with, the workload for the new semester was discussed for both Hons. and Programme courses, specifically the scheme (CBCS/LOCF) for each batch and the number of classes required for each paper.

- → For B.A. Hons Psychology, it was confirmed that LOCF would be applicable for the 1st and 2nd year students, while CBCS would be applicable for the 3rd year students.
- → For B.A. Programme, all three years would be taught under the scheme of CBCS since there is no information from the main department of the university, regarding change of CBCS to LOCF.
- → For papers with Theory and Tutorials 5 lectures plus 4 tuts.
- → For papers with Theory and Practicum 4 lectures, plus total 16 practical classes (2 practicals X 4 groups X 2 periods).
- → Total strength of the 2020-2021 second year and third year batches for both B.A. (Hons.) and B.A. (Prog.) was discussed:
  - ◆ B.A. (Hons.)
    2020-2021 second year 48
    2020-2021 third year 47
  - ◆ B.A. (Prog.)
    2020-2021 second year 56
    2020-2021 third year 51
- → Regarding the DSE papers for B.A. Hons. Third year, the students have selected the following papers based on class consensus Positive Psychology (Theory + Practical) and Community Psychology (Theory + Practical).
- → Furthermore, Dr. Sneh Kapoor raised a concern about the GE paper for B.A. Programme Third year students. As the number of students who opt for this paper varies each year, she suggested that it might be a good idea to decide beforehand how many sections the department would be able accommodate for the same. However, suggestions from other members led to the decision that the department should continue to offer two sections for this paper, as has been the practice in the past few years as per the suggestion of the Principal.
  - ◆ Dr. Vinita Kshetrapal suggested that the workload for the two sections can be divided among two teachers in such a way, that even if there were any significant change in the class strength leading to the removal of one section, then it will be ensured that the workload of the concerned teachers would not go below their required number of classes.
- → Dr. Joan Antony (Teacher-In-Charge) will make the final chart of the workload and discuss with the senior teachers in the department.

### **Concerns Expressed by the Students**

- → A discussion was also held on the concerns expressed by the students in light of the impending Open Book Examinations.
- → Dr. Priya Bhatnagar expressed that the students of B.A. Program third year have shared their distress and anxiety repeatedly with respect to the OBE. She informed that the students reported experiencing a toll in their mental health as a result of the uncertainty surrounding the same.
- → Dr. Sneh Kapoor also mentioned that third year students of B.A. Hons. Psychology have also expressed similar concerns. Students who are living outside Delhi are especially concerned about their apprehended inability to give the OBEs as they are facing disruptions in electricity and internet. Some students also don't have access to all the study material as they went home for vacations and are now stuck there without all their material.
- → Ms. Annie Baxi also added that some students have contacted her and requested if teachers could assist them in this case with respect to giving concrete examples of what kind of questions can be asked in the exam, as they're apprehensive about the new format. They have also expressed concerns about what application/mechanism can be employed to scan and upload their answer sheets (as CamScanner has been discontinued by the App stores).
- → It was suggested that the teachers should keep in touch with the students to help manage their anxieties and doubts regarding the same. Dr. Antony also thanked Ms. Sudha Shashwati for calling each third year student in the past few days.
- $\rightarrow$  She further instructed that the teachers should keep in touch with 1<sup>st</sup>, 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students also in the next few days.
- → Ms. Baxi shared another crucial case of a student who has broken her hand and now needs assistance in order to give the examinations. The student has shared her plight that in order to successfully finish her exams she'd need a writer, however she has been instructed (presumably by the admin office) to get a medical certificate sanctioned by the Chief Medical Officer of South Campus for the same. However, the student is currently not in Delhi and thus, will be unable to do so.
  - ◆ The department decided that it would be wise for the student to mail her request (with her presently available medical certificates) to the Principal of our college, Teacher-In-charge, and the admin office.

# **Events Conducted by the Department**

- → The farewell for the graduating batch of 2020 was conducted by first and second year students on 8th June, 2020 using an online platform (Google Meet).
- → On 19th June, 2020, the department conducted a Webinar on the topic, "In a Relationship...With the Screen!" Prof. Aseem Shrivastava was the speaker for the same.

- → An online meeting was held on 28th June, 2020 for the third year students (2020-2021) regarding DSE papers' orientation. Voting for the same was conducted using Google Forms.
- → Due to the uncertainty of the pandemic situation and its related impact on the academic session (closing date of semester, re-opening of the college, exam schedules, assessment & uploading of assignments and practical/project marks, etc.), all senior teachers were informed of the farewell only two days in advance. However, Dr. Ameeta Parsuram expressed feeling excluded in the planning stage. Dr. Joan Antony tried explaining the same.
- → Finally, the meeting was concluded by Dr. Joan Antony thanking the department for the successful completion of all activities and events.
