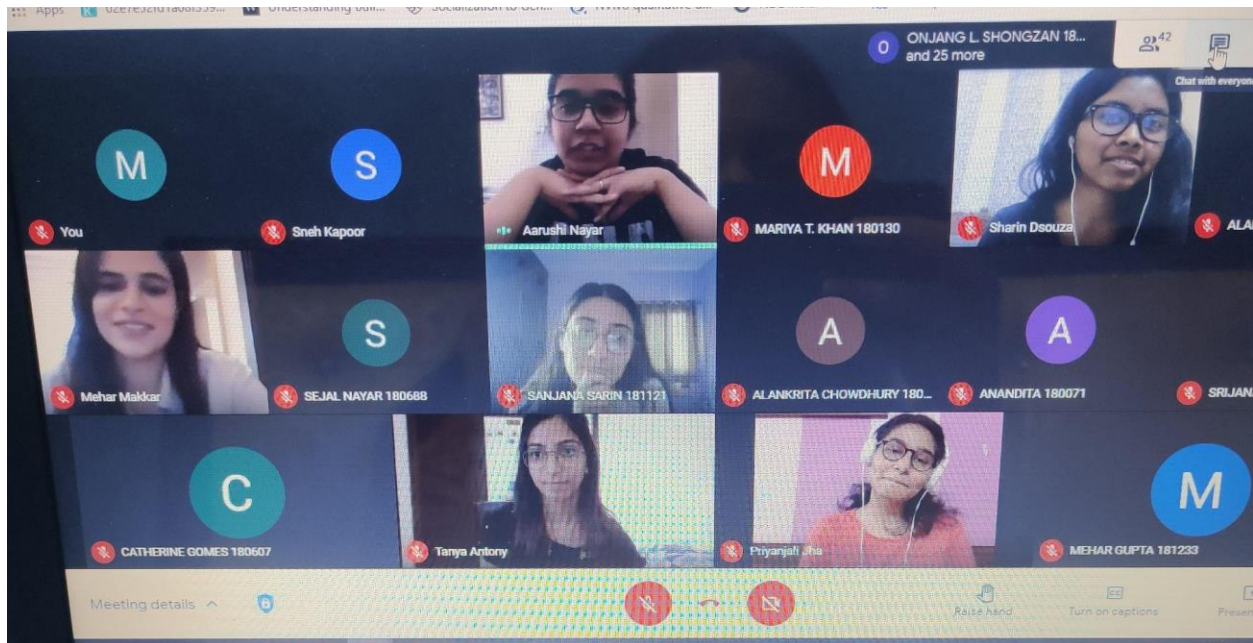
### **Session on Opportunities for Higher Education**

A career session was organised for the final year students of the psychology department on 13th April, 2021 via Google Meet by Dr. Sneh Kapoor and Ms. Bhumika Kapoor (Association In-Charges). Some students from other departments with psychology as their GE subject also joined. The session was geared towards providing the students information about prospects in psychology after graduation, particularly from the perspective of higher education. Former students of the department across different batches were invited to provide a brief orientation into what Masters level program options were available to the students, and how to go about applying to them.

Each of the invited speakers provided a detailed insight into their journey since graduation – the steps they took and the hurdles they faced along the way. They covered various universities across the country – ranging from University of Delhi, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Amity University, Christ University, Ambedkar University, among others. They spoke at great length about their preparations for the entrance exams, the format of these exams, what to expect at the interview stage and its preparation, and how they finally decided what courses to enrol for. They spoke of the different course requirements, course options, and factors to consider during the application stage.

In addition, they also oriented students towards the different internship programs they had undertaken, as well as research projects they were a part of. Some of the graduates also discussed fellowships they had applied for, as well as the possibility of a gap year and how best to utilise the time during it.

The final year students benefited greatly from this discussion and had a lengthy question and answer session following the initial orientation. Questions pertaining to course fee structure, scholarships, program structure etc were addressed at length. The scope of the programmes in terms of employability and further research and career options in the field were also discussed. The programme lasted about 3 hours and allowed the students to tap into their alumni network for help and guidance.

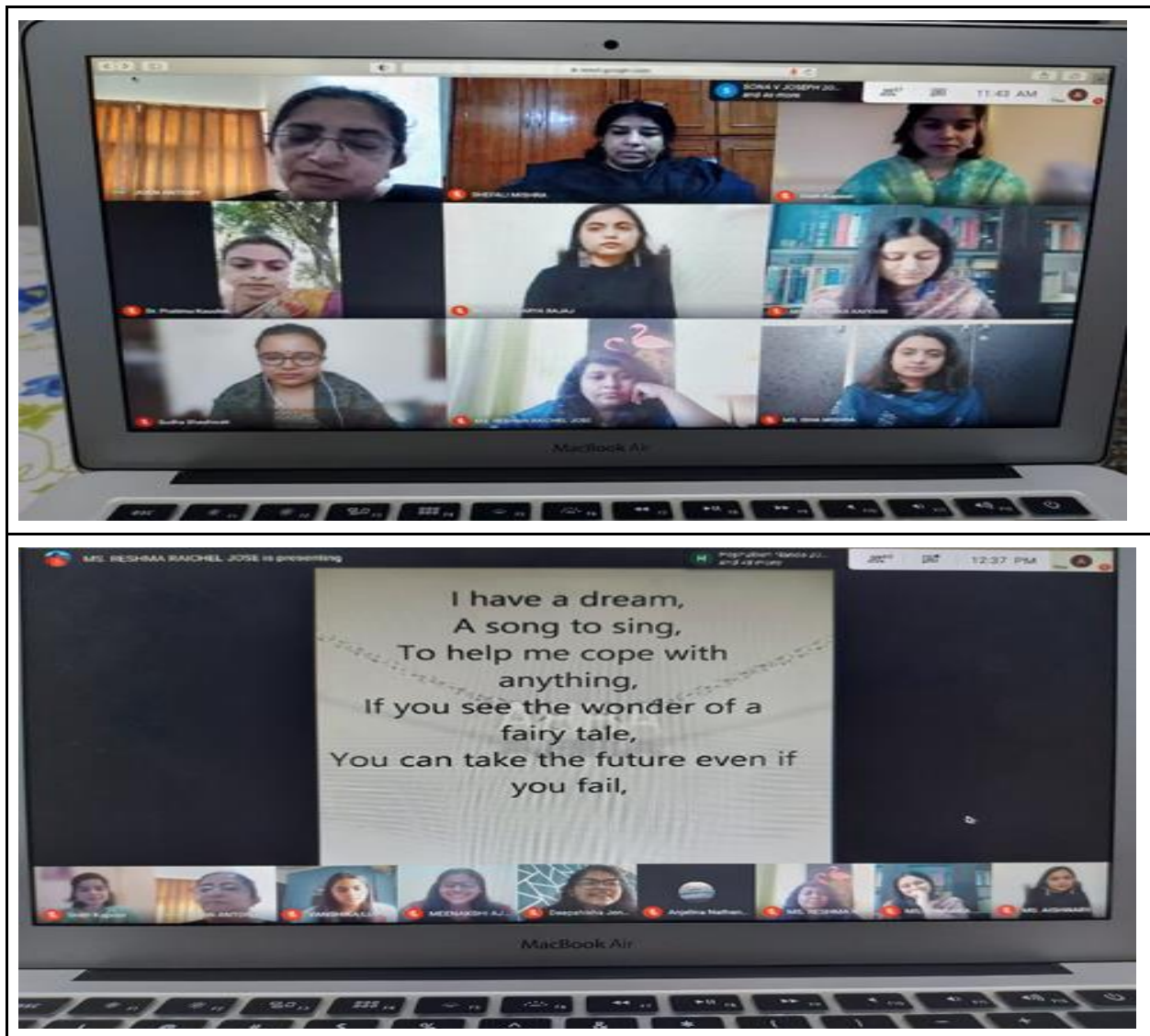

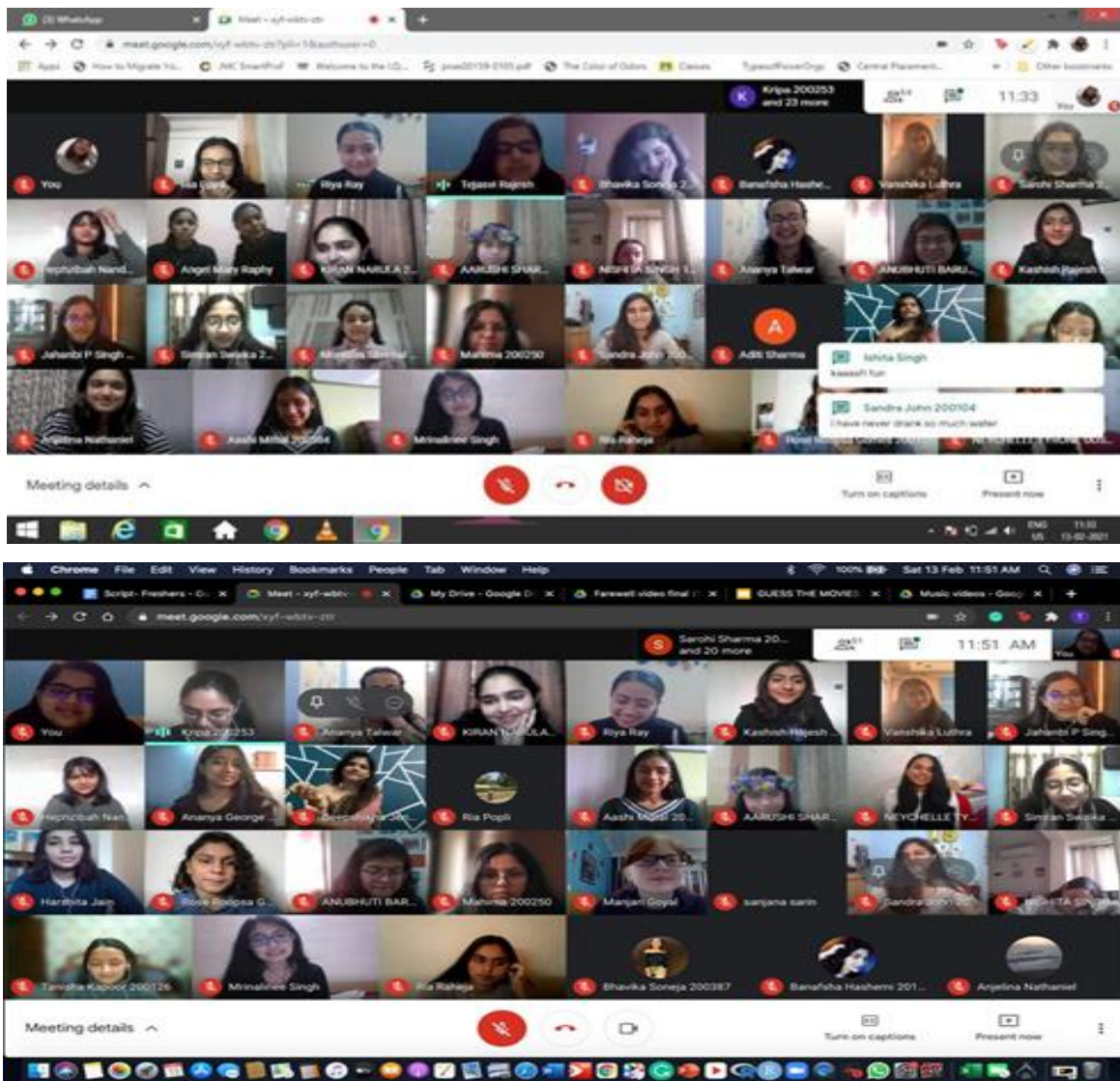

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# **Outstanding Visitors to the Department in the Course of the Academic Year**

## **Community Psychology Guest Lecture**

Date: 28/10/2020

**Title** - Loitering in the Slums of Mumbai: Communicating with Communities

**Guest Speaker** - Ms. Vaidehi Chilwarwar (MPhil), Arts Based Therapist and Doctoral Research Scholar, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai

**Speaker Bio** - Ms. Vaidehi Chilwarwar has 5 years' experience in working on community mental health projects. She is a final year PhD scholar in TISS, Mumbai, who is working on an intervention-based action research. She is also a practicing arts-based therapist trained at Bapu Trust, Pune.

**Summary** - The 45 minute lecture held over Google Meet entailed first-hand narratives of the speaker's experiences as a researcher in a slum community in Mumbai. The pragmatic nature of fieldwork or "what works in reality" was the central focus of it. Students gained exposure to intervention-based action research in a community mental health framework in the Indian context. Interaction with students was an important element of the lecture through activities demonstrating culturally appropriate ways of rapport building. Last 5 minutes were devoted to answering students' queries.

The lecture was divided into the following four segments:

1. Entry in the community as an outsider - Looking at the major personal and ethical codes to be accepted in the community
2. Bridging gaps as a researcher - Use of language and clothing, and delivering age-appropriate information
3. Existing community practices as strengths - Exploring existing arts based, cultural rituals to facilitate coping
4. Personal ethics with adolescents - Re-thinking group work without punishments and penalties

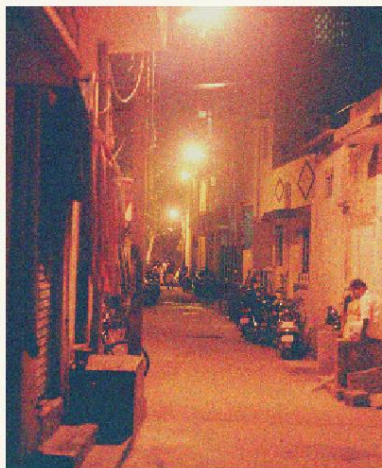
