- **Brief history of the College**

The Jesus and Mary College, a constituent college of the University of Delhi, was established by the Congregation of Jesus and Mary in 1968. This religious congregation was founded by Saint Claudine Thevenet in Lyon (France) in 1818. The College opened with one department offering English (Hons) and B.A.(Pass) Courses with an enrolment of 116 students. In the span of a few years students could choose from many more options of Honours Courses, including Economics, Political Science, Hindi, Psychology, B.Com, and B.Com Pass Course. In the year 2000, the road in front of the college was renamed 'Jesus and Mary College Marg'. Ms. Sheila Dixit, Chief Minister of Delhi, and His Grace Alan de Lastic, Archbishop of Delhi graced the occasion. In 2006 a fully equipped State-of-the-Art Multi Purpose Hall (MPH), named 'Saint Claudine Thevenet Hall' was inaugurated and blessed by Archbishop Vincent Concessao. In 2021 the College awarded an 'A+' Grade in the second cycle of accreditation by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). In 2016 JMC became one of the three colleges in Delhi University to introduce two professional degree programs- B.Voc Healthcare Management and B.Voc Retail Management & IT, sponsored by UGC under PMKVY.

- **Extension and Outreach Activities**

Jesus and Mary College organized extension activities in the neighbourhood community that sensitize students towards community issues, cleanliness drive, social inclusion, etc., and teach social values and commitment to society. From 2022 to 2023,

several activities/events were conducted that bridged the gap between academia and society/ community.

- **Jesus and Mary College Educational Programme (JMCEP)** organized regular teaching and weekly dance classes for the kids from the nearby communities. On Children's Day, a garden activity day filled with games, dancing, and singing was conducted. JMCEP along with **Curiosis, Quiz Society JMC**, organized a quiz on the ongoing social issues and current affairs. A drawing activity on the theme 'Holi Celebrations' was also organised. A seminar on The Importance of Women's Education was conducted on 28th October 2022.
- **The Community Engagement Center (CEC)** launched a Tailoring Course, from 15th February, 2023 to 19th May, 2023. During the three-month course, participants from the nearby communities of Sanjay Camp, Vivekananda Camp and Babu Dham Society made significant progress in their tailoring skills. CEC collaborated with JMCEP to organize a program for the women on the theme 'Digit-all: Innovation and Technology for Gender Equality'. CEC organized a workshop on competitive examinations for CA for NCWEB students. CEC organized a visit to Barclays, Nehru Place, for 11 students of NCWEB to attend a motivational session. CEC and NCWEB, JMC, in collaboration with New Delhi District Legal Services Authority, organized a Nukkad Natak to raise awareness against acid attack violence. An awareness session to give information about provisions in the Indian Penal Code 1860, CrPC 1973, and Delhi Victim Compensation scheme with regard to acid attacks was conducted. On 31st March 2023, Dr. Wendy Bignold, Associate Dean, Liverpool Hope University U.K., visited the CEC and interacted with the women and children of JMCEP. CEC organized an online orientation session for NCWEB students for entry-level jobs. A session on investment banking for NCWEB students of commerce was conducted. CEC, in collaboration with Kailash Satyarthi Children's Foundation, organized an awareness session on Menstrual Hygiene Day and distributed women's hygiene products to women from the community.
- **Enactus JMC** strives to work towards empowering people from marginalized segments by creating livelihood opportunities. On 25th January 2023, Project Sugam members visited their eco-brick storage facility to conduct a quality check on the eco-bricks made by Jaago Bharat. Project Sugam organized an awareness session on sustainability and taught Dayanand Model school kids how to make eco-bricks. A Breast Cancer Awareness Seminar was conducted in collaboration with Win over Cancer, providing a comprehensive overview of breast cancer, its treatment, and the importance of early detection in January 2023.
- **National Service Scheme (NSS)** JMC, conducted a cleanliness drive in the JMC campus from 15th February 2023 to 17th February 2023. NSS, JMC donated essentials to the Turkish and Syrian Embassies on 14 February 2023. NSS, JMC celebrated Christmas at NGO Prabhatara. On World Soil Day, NSS, JMC hosted a Plantation Drive.
- **National Cadet Corps, JMC** actively participated in various camps/activities and also won many awards. Some of the activities are blood donation camps, a Slum

Visit- as a part of the Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign, and a Visit to the Prabhatara Institute of Social Service in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture, Government of India, Nasha Mukti Abhiyan Nukkad Natak, to name a few.

• **Library Development**

Jesus and Mary College library was established in 1968 along with the inception of college. The library block is located at the heart of the college campus, covering an expansive area of 1686.81 sq.m., and is spread over three floors. Its infrastructure is state-of-the-art; the library is fully air-conditioned, wi-fi enabled with a seating capacity of 220.

The library houses two large reading rooms, stack areas, reference section and e-resource centre. The college library serves as a resource centre for both printed and electronic resources. The JMC Library also provides a large collection of reference sources (for e.g., encyclopedias, dictionaries, atlases, yearbooks, handbooks etc.) in addition to various textbooks and other reading materials. The library has a huge collection of about 62,000 books on various subjects. The library subscribes to 67 journals, popular magazines and periodicals along with 12 newspapers. Subscription to INFLIBNET- NLIST & DULS databases is also available for better research and academic pursuits.

The library uses Troodon ILMS software, version 5.6, provided by Comtek Services. Key features of the software are its easy-to-use Graphical UI, unicode support with Multilingual Search and export facility for most reports. The library operates on the basis of an 'Open Access' system. The OPAC module of the software allows for a full search of the library database by entering preferred terms, making information retrieval a seamless process. The Circulation module of the software covers all circulatory operations; from creating member records to printing reminders for outstanding books. The Database Maintenance module includes operations of database creation and maintenance. It uses the acquisition module for data on recently acquired books.

The library also has access to a fully automated anti-plagiarism software, URKUND. Two informations kiosks have been added to the library infrastructure in the year 2023, making it easier to search for books in the library. Through these various frameworks, the JMC Library presents a modern, automated approach to management.
