



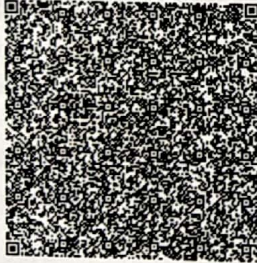
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Memorandum of Understanding

Jesus And Mary College, New Delhi and Concordia College – New York

This letter formalizes a relationship between JESUS AND MARY COLLEGE Delhi, located in Chanakyapuri , New Delhi– 110021,India(hereinafter referred as JMC) - and Concordia College New York, located in 171, White Plains Road, Bronxville, New York State (hereinafter CCNY) of


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the United States. The intent of the two educational institutions is to develop a long-term mutually beneficial relationship whereby JMC students may be eligible to enroll and participate in an AMERICAN TRANSFER PROGRAM (ATP) of academic study at CCNY. On successful completion of the course the students will be conferred an Undergrad degree by CCNY in their field of study.


Set forth below is the understanding between JMC and CCNY in support of a program for JMC, Delhi- students:

1. JMC students will have completed at least two years of full-time academic work at JMC Delhi.
2. JMC students will have earned an overall GPA of 7.0 or 70% and higher (on a 10.0 scale), or the equivalent at JMC - and have taken the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) exam.
3. The specific courses of study included in this collaborative arrangement are: Bachelors of Business Administration, Commerce, English and all other relevant Courses of Study offered by JMC.
4. The nomenclature of the degrees awarded by CCNY is as listed:

Biology (B.A), Business Administration (B.S), Education (B.A), English (B.A) ,Health Studies (B.S), Social Sciences (B.A), Liberal Studies (B.A), Nursing (B.S), Social Work (B.S).
5. The intended target number for this program is expected to be around 10 students per annum.
6. JMC students that are accepted by CCNY will be offered a scholarship (amount as per annexure II). Students will be responsible for the balance of CCNY's standard costs and fees then in effect; Students will be required to reside on campus.
7. CCNY reserves the right to modify fee structure annually.
8. Students of JMC will be able to continue their respective undergraduate courses at JMC in the instance of the student VISA not being granted to them by the competent authorities.
9. CCNY would place an endowment fund in the name of JMC - (as per annexure III.)



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10. CCNY –India Liaison office would guide and support students of JMC in aspects of educational loan, Visa process, Pre –Departure services etc. and CCNY will ensure post landing services.

11. Credit mapping for JMC students will be done at Concordia College -New York by the academic team of CCNY upon receipt of the student's application to CCNY.

12. In general, 75-80 credits are transferred to CCNY from the Indian institutions depending on the Courses the students complete.

13. In order to complete the undergraduate education at CCNY, students require a minimum of 122 credits at the end of the final (Three) semesters.

14. Students who plan for inter-discipline cross over (eg: B.COM to English or Psychology) shall however get their syllabus evaluated and mapped by the CCNY academic teams much ahead of time to gain clarity on the possibility of such a provision. CCNY would be willing to individually map the syllabus, provided the students has shown considerable interest in joining CCNY by paying the enrollment deposits.


15. CCNY-India Liaison office will continue to be the touch point for JMC, and the parents to interact and understand the students' status while they are in New York.


16. Students pay CCNY fees in US dollars.

17. Duration of this agreement is for three years, effective from the date of signing and would be renewed mutually for further periods.

18. CCNY and JMC will also actively plan and implement a staff and student exchange program between the two institutions. (as per Annexure I)

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
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19. One-Credit programs will be conducted for the students by CCNY faculty at JMC, during July –August depending on the success of the College to recruit students into CCNY.




