
Intra-Inter Department and College Collaboration







Concept Note for Carpe Diem 2018

The Department of Sociology, Jesus and Mary College is hosting its annual festival, Carpe Diem on Thursday, 11th October, 2018. The theme for the festival this year is 'Ways of Gendering: Critical Perspectives on Empowerment'. Through this theme, we intend to engage with gender empowerment as a discursive category, with the broad aim to deconstruct its understanding as it exists at the level of common-sense, as well as at the level of traditional academic discourses. We wish to problematize the common and usual ways of defining empowerment by questioning aspects that are popularly considered empowering. In this endeavor what would become pertinent is not just enquiring into what empowerment constitutes, but also what it perhaps does not. Through sub-themes such as religion and identity, feminism and femininity, abuse, gender and aesthetics, and an array of events around these themes, we wish to draw attention to alternative understanding of empowerment in the sense it has traditionally not been understood. This alternative understanding would do more than just offer a few answers about what empowerment is; it would perhaps leave us with questions that offer further opportunities to explore and develop a more critical and holistic understanding of gender and empowerment.



From Purdah to Picadilly: A Muslim Woman's Struggle for Identity', which is an autobiography that showcases Bhatty's journey through constraints of gender, culture, religion and society, from inside the Zenana to the forefront of the movement for women's empowerment in India. She outlines her journey through life and self-discovery through experiences of family, marriage, education and work within larger society.

Zarina Bhatty is former President of the Indian Association for Women's Studies, and of the Young Women's Christian Association, New Delhi. She has worked extensively on the issues faced by Indian Muslim Women, and women in the unorganized sector. She studied Sociology and Political Science at the London School of Economics and went on to work as a Gender Specialist with USAID, IFAD and IDB. She has also taught at Jesus and Mary College, University of Delhi. Her work has been path-breaking and she has garnered considerable recognition, and has been the recipient of a number of awards.

b) Turn-Coat Debate: Tark-Vitark

Keeping in mind the overall theme of the fest, the topic of the turncoat debate competition was 'Feminism and Femininity'. The motion for the debate was given to the participants thirty minutes prior to the commencement of the event.

The event was governed by the following rules:

- 1. The total duration of speaking was limited to four minutes for each speaker.
- 2. Each speaker had to change their stance at the moment alerted by a bell struck two minutes into their speech.
- 3. On account of exceeding the time limit, negative marks were allotted.

The debate was bilingual i.e. use of both Hindi and English was allowed.

For purpose of intellectual and detailed judgment of the participants the Department of Sociology with guidance of the English Debating Society constructed a panel of judges incorporating faculty of the various departments of Jesus and Mary College.

There were in total four judges. Lavanya ma'am from the Department of Economics, Sandhya Nambiar and Ishita Singh from the English Department and Amita Tiwari from the Department of Hindi.

The two participants awarded who were ranked first were Nitish Kr. Pandey from Sri Aurobindo College and Arjun Sharma from Sri Venkateswara College. The two participants to win the Second position were Jagrit Chauhan, Sri Venkateswara College and Antara Rao from Jesus and Mary College. c) Slam Poetry: Jazbaat

The Department also organised a Slam Poetry Competition, which took place in the Seminar Roomfrom noon till 2pm, on the topic 'Abuse' where young poets from different schools and colleges whose poems were shortlisted were given an opportunity to orate their ideas and interpretations. A time limit of 5 minutes was given to present either English or Hindipoems. The theme 'Abuse' may direct one's attention towards the commonsensical notion of a woman being abused. However, what delighted the judges Mr. Jobin and Ms. Aneesha, from the English Department of Jesus & Mary College, were the nuances present in the participants poems. The students went beyond the everyday parlance in which abuse is used to talk about the emotional abuse that a parent's 'love' overshadows or the abhorrent details of physical abuse that a small boy faces in the hands of his uncle or simply using an inanimate object such as a bus to describe the feelings of every individual when Nirbhaya was gangraped on a moving bus. A total of fifteen impactful poems were showcased amongst an audience of thirty people, leaving them with a thousand thoughts.

Out of the 15 participants, the first position was awarded to Rajat Sood, a student of Delhi Technological University, the second position to Manavi Chauhan and the third position with to Meenakshi Acharya, both belonging to colleges of Delhi University. There were two honourable mentions for Anshika and Akanksha for presenting beautiful poems through their great oratory skills. The winners were given cash prizes and certificates.

d) Photography Competition: Ullas-Tration

An online photography competition was also organised with the theme 'GENDER AND AESTHETICS', which was held in the Multi-Purpose Hall from 12:45 onwards. All the Students from various colleges and universities in Delhi/NCR were eligible to participate. 
