Dear Charu,

Hi! Taking forward the points discussed on Wednesday to finalize the Art Program for the 1<sup>st</sup> Year students of Jesus and Mary College. Listing it all out, as the following-

1. The art program shall be called 'Kala-Kshetra' and Kiran Nadar Museum of Art shall sponsor the 30 hrs program spread over a period of five months.
2. KNMA shall be providing a total of 15 Art workshops of 2 hrs each, the topics for which I shall share in a separate email.
3. KNMA shall additionally be giving a certificate of participation for the program to all the students.
4. The program shall be assessed by our Art Coordinators on the following parameters-
  - a. Creativity (Originality, imagination and Ideas).
  - b. Executing the Ideas.
  - c. Neatness in work.
  - d. Final artwork (output/result)
  - e. Students Involvement in the workshop.
5. Additionally, the art coordinators shall also be marking an attendance for the students, (list to be provided by you).
6. The assessment will have a cumulative score of 25 Marks at the end of the program and in addition to the Art coordinators' remarks for each student.
7. We understand that for certain topics if one workshop is not enough, considering the level of artwork - the same can be divided into 2 or 3 workshops but the number of sessions shall remain the same i.e. 15 sessions.
8. Also, the students can work individually or collaboratively, as in a group of two-four.
9. The girls shall be asked to maintain a portfolio to document their journey during the program, which at the end of the program shall also be used as a referral for your teachers.
10. The sessions are going to be held on 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday every month, starting from September 2018-January 2019 at KNMA, Saket.
11. The September sessions are finalised for 15<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> Sep 2018 at KNMA, Saket.
12. For certain specific workshops like Pottery, the venue might shift to KNMA, NOIDA which shall be decided in advance and communicated to students and college accordingly and transportation shall also be provided for the same.

I have enlisted all the pointers just in case, if otherwise, please feel free to revert on the same.
