AGREEMENT (IAHV)

JESUS AND MARY COLLEGE (JMC)

This Agreement dated October 2022 (the "Agreement"), is made and entered into by and between International Association for Human Values (IAHV), registered under Registrar of Societies, having its registered office at 216-C, Humayunpur, Opposite to B-6/98, Safdarjung Enclave New Delhi 110029, India, hereinafter referred to as "IAHV" (which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof shall mean and include its successors in interest, administrators and permitted assigns) AND

Jesus and Mary College, established in 1968, is administered by the Provincial Society, Delhi (Congregation of Jesus and Mary) an institution of the Provincial Society of the Religious of Jesus and Mary registered under the Societies Registration Act of XXI 1860 (Punjab Amendment) Act, as extended to the Union Territory of Delhi, having its registered office at Convent of Jesus and Mary, New Delhi 110001. Jesus and Mary College hereinafter referred to as "JMC" (which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof shall mean and include its successors in interest, administrators and permitted assigns) of the OTHER PART.

IAHV and JMC wish to work together to set up a Community Engagement Centre (CEC) at JMC's college premises at Jesus and Mary College, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi 110021, hereinafter referred to as the "Project".

IAHV and JMC have agreed that the Project shall be governed by the terms and conditions set out below.

PURPOSE OF CEC

1. The CEC is being set-up to organize, facilitate, conduct social and development programs for the needy. Examples of such programs include Skill Development training, Digital Literacy Workshops, Financial Literacy Workshops, Menstrual Awareness Programs etc.

CEC shall initially focus on programs for girls and women and can later undertake programs for other target groups upon mutual agreement of JMC and IAHV.

EXPENSES FOR SETTING-UP AND OPERATIONS OF CEC

- 4. IAHV agrees to incur the necessary expenses to set up the CEC at location in JMC's premises jointly identified by JMC and IAHV.
- 5. IAHV agrees to support the running of the CEC till a mutually decided timeline or until the expiry of this Agreement, whichever is earlier.
- IAHV shall support the honorarium of one JMC resource person who shall be single
 point of contact from JMC for IAHV to facilitate the CEC's functioning. The
 honorarium shall be mutually decided by IAHV and JMC.

OWNERSHIP OF ASSETS

7. IAHV shall own the movable assets being provided by IAHV at the CEC.

MANAGEMENT OF CEC

- IAHV and JMC shall jointly run the CEC for which a suitable committee "CEC Management Committee" shall be constituted.
- IAHV and JMC shall make all efforts to keep each other informed and updated on the CEC's activities.

TERM

- 10. This agreement shall be valid for three years from the date of signing.
- 11. IAHV and JMC shall jointly review the CEC's sustenance before the expiry of this Agreement and can mutually decide to renew this Agreement further.

CONFIDENTIALITY

12. No news releases, public announcements, advertising materials, or confirmation of any media or third-party inquiry, concerning the existence of this Agreement or the developing between IAHV and JMC may be issued or made without the prior written appropriate CEC Managing Committee.

13. COMPLIANCES

- 15. IAHV and JMC both represent and warrant that they will comply with applicable laws and regulations regarding anti-corruption, bribery or any other law regarding improper payment or influence, as well as anti-bribery policy prohibiting any illegal or improper influence or payment in connection with this Agreement.
- 16. IAHV and JMC individually bear the responsibility of complying with all laws, rules and regulations applicable to its activities under the Project and in relation to their individual legal status. Both individually shall also be responsible for the compliance of all applicable labour laws of all its employees or contractors engaged in connection with or in relation to the Project, including the payment of salaries/wages and statutory payments.
- 17. IAHV and JMC jointly agree to report promptly any actual, alleged or attempted violation of any Anti-Corruption Law arising in connection with the Project and to cooperate with each other in investigating and responding to such actual, alleged or attempted violation.

REPORTING

18. JMC and IAHV mutually agree to use audio-visual recordings of the CEC activities for use in their literature and promotional materials, which may include its website and social media channels.

19. CEC Management Committee shall maintain true and accurate records relating to its arises under the Project.

20. Any notice, direction or other documentation required or remitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and may only be given by personal delivery, courier, or electronic mail (with confirmation received) at the addresses mentioned above.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 21. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Subject to the arbitration provisions set out below, the parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of any competent courts situated in New Delhi in relation to any action arising out of or relating to this Agreement and waive any objection to such proceedings on grounds of venue or on the grounds that the proceedings have been brought in an inconvenient forum.
- 22. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, including any question regarding its existence, validity or termination, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration under the Indian Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended (the "Arbitration Act").
- 23. The number of arbitrators shall be one, to be jointly appointed by both the Parties, failing which an arbitrator will be appointed in accordance with the Arbitration Act. The seat, or legal place, of arbitration shall be New Delhi. The language to be used in the arbitration shall be English.

SIGNING AUTHORITY

24. Each person signing this Agreement represents and warrants that he or she is duly authorized and has legal capacity to execute and deliver the Agreement.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

LIVERPOOL HOPE UNIVERSITY

and

JESUS AND MARY COLLEGE

BETWEEN:

LIVERPOOL HOPE UNIVERSITY, whose registered office is at Hope Park, Liverpool, L16 9JD ('The University'),

and

JESUS AND MARY COLLEGE whose registered office is at San Martin Marg, Bapu dham, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi- 110021 ("The Partner")

(together referred to as "the Parties" or in the singular as a "Party")

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Parties believe that mutual benefit can be derived from entering into a cooperative relationship for the general purpose of providing opportunities for students, staff and/or other collaborative activity.
- 1.2 This memorandum of understanding is established to further the mutual interests of, and to foster and develop cooperation between the Parties in accordance with their individual mission and objectives.
- 1.3 This memorandum of understanding sets out principles by which the University and the Partner can establish a formal arrangement regarding such activity.

2. PRINCIPLES

- 2.1 Any activity carried out within the broad framework of this memorandum of understanding shall be subject to the mutual consent of both Parties, taking into account any constraints of time, funding and other relevant resources.
- 2.2 The Parties acknowledge that this memorandum of understanding does not place them under any obligation to enter into any subsequent agreement or arrangement or any obligation to negotiate such agreement.
- 2.3 Aside from clause 5, this memorandum of understanding is not intended to be legally binding and shall not be enforceable in any court of law. Either Party may withdraw at any time from this memorandum of understanding without incurring any liability to the other Party.

FURTHER AGREEMENT

3.1 Where the Parties agree to proceed with a specific activity or programme subsequent to the signing of this memorandum of understanding, it is the Parties' intention to enter into separate written agreements which shall be negotiated and mutually agreed.

4. DURATION OF THE UNDERSTANDING

4.1 This memorandum of understanding shall terminate automatically on the signing by the Parties of a partnership agreement which will set out in more detail the areas of co-operation agreed and the responsibilities of the Parties. If no such partnership agreement is entered into within one year of the date hereof, this memorandum of understanding shall automatically terminate unless mutually agreed between both Parties.

5. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

- 5.1 The Parties have not, by virtue of this memorandum of understanding, entered into a joint venture or any other form of relationship, and neither party may act or hold itself out as agent of the other, or in any other way entitled to pledge the credit or otherwise incur legal liability on behalf of the other party.
- 5.2 This memorandum of understanding and the negotiations between the Parties in connection with any planned future partnership, the agreements between the Parties, and all matters disputes and claims arising out of, or in connection with them, will be governed by, and construed in accordance with, English law. Each Party irrevocably agrees to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
- 5.3 The terms set out in this memorandum of understanding are for the benefit of the Parties to them and are not intended to benefit, or be enforceable by, anyone else under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 or otherwise.

MOU FOR VIDYA VISTAR SCHEME

Memorandum of Understanding under the Vidya Vistar Scheme

Among

THE UNIVERSITY OF DELHI,

JESUS AND MARY COLLEGE of the University of Delhi, New Delhi

And

ST. JOSEPH'S GIRLS DEGREE COLLEGE of the CCS University, Saradana, Meerut, UP

This Tripartite Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered under the Vidya Vistar Scheme (hereinafter referred to as V2Scheme), an initiative of the University of Delhi to establish academic linkages between its Colleges and Departments with the corresponding Institute in remote areas of the country.

Among

The University of Delhi a University enacted under the Act of Parliament (*Act No VIII of 1922*), having its office at Vice Regal Lodge, North Campus, Delhi-110007, and represented by its REGISTRAR, of the **First Party**

JESUS AND MARY COLLEGE of the University of Delhi, having its registered office at Chanakyapuri, New Delhi - 110021, represented by Prof. Sandra Joseph Principal, Prof. Sandra Joseph, of the Second Party

and

ST. JOSEPH'S GIRLS DEGREE COLLEGE, having its registered office at Sardhana-2503422, Meerut, UP represented by Dr. Sr. Christina, Principal of the Third Party.

The Second and Third parties shall be jointly referred to as 'Partner institutes' and all the three parties shall be jointly referred to as 'Parties'.

Recognizing the India's dream to be a global superpower in the coming decades depends primarily on enhancing the skills of its human resources to meet global demands and increasing innovations and start-ups to fuel the economy. The roles that the universities, colleges and other educational institutions have to play is crucial in this context

Realising that alone, each Party will require investment of considerable amount of its resources for the developmental activities. However, being a developing country, it would be in the best interest to maximise the utilization of existing resources available with the Universities/ academic institutions by sharing the same, through academic collaboration and cooperation amongst them, for augmenting the human resources.

Therefore, the Parties witnesseth as under, which defines the framework for the cooperation of the Partner institutes in the following sections -

- 1. The Parties are agreeing to partner under V2Scheme for the purpose of enhancing the mutual growth and development of each other.
- 2. The academic bonding is based on the principle of mutual respect, cooperation and sharing between the two parties as equal partners.
- 3. The Second Party shall extend its academic resources and facilities available for the V2Scheme to the Third Party with an aim to be catalyst for the faster growth of the latter. The Third Party shall share it academic resources with the Second Party to the extent possible, on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education and research.
- 4. The areas of cooperation between the two Partner institutes shall include the following:
 - 4.1. Organize online/ offline lectures, workshops, trainings, meetings and other such programmes aimed at capacity building of the faculty members of both the Partner institutes. To the extent possible, visits of faculties will be facilitated for this purpose.

- 4.2. The teachers and researchers of the both the Partner institutes may be engaged in Joint research activities and be co-investigators in the research programmes submitted to funding agencies.
- 4.3. Joint research publication by teachers/ researchers of the Partner institutes shall be encouraged.
- 4.4. Library resources may be shared for providing support in capacity building of the faculty and for improvement of their teaching and research skills.
- 4.5. To forge mutually beneficial linkages with its partners through various platforms so as to initiate and assist innovation activities and boost start-ups.
- 4.6. To cultivate the feeling of brotherhood among youths of the two institutes through sports and extracurricular activities.

5. Intellectual Property Rights:

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software, and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested in Partner institutes to this MoU. The Partner institutes shall have the joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of such intellectual property, and Partner Institutes shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Before any registration or commercialization of any intellectual property takes place, the Partner institutes agree to reach a separate agreement covering issues such as exploitation rights and revenue sharing. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with the prior written consent of Partner institutes, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld. University of Delhi shall be free to use perpetually the results arising out of the collaborating activities for its own internal teaching, research, educational, clinical and publication purposes without the payment of royalties or other fees to the other parties.

6. The University of Delhi shall facilitate in the process of establishing partnership under this Scheme. It shall oversee the general implementation of the V2Scheme.

- The Second Party shall submit a report to the University of Delhi within seven days of completion of any activity taken up under V2Scheme.
- The MoU will come into force from the date of putting the last signature on this MoU.
- 9. The MoU shall be for a duration of three years.
- 10. The Parties may renew the MoU for a further period of the same duration with mutual consent of the Parties. The process for renewal may be initiated three months prior to the expiry of the term of the MoU by any of the two Partner institutes.
- 11. The MoU may be terminated prior to the completion of the term by any Party to the MoU by giving one month prior written notice to the other two Parties. Once terminated, neither parties will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institute may suffer.
- 12. However, any ongoing project, course, joint research or publication which have been initiated by the Partner institutes prior to the date of termination shall be continued as if no termination has taken place.
- 13. The MoU is intended to be an expression of general understanding and intention of the Parties. The Parties shall make earnest effort to carry out the tasks undertaken in this MoU. However, it shall not be an agreement enforceable in a court of law. Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.
- 14. Any disagreement/ differences/ dispute between the Partner institutes shall be resolved through mutual discussion between them. In case any dispute remains unresolved, the decision of the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Delhi shall be final and binding on both the Partner institutes.
- 15. In case of any force majeure, such as flood, earthquake, epidemic, etc. the Partner institutes shall be excused from performing obligations which are directly impacted by any act of force majeure.

- 16. This MoU constitutes the complete agreement between the Parties with respect to the collaboration under V2Scheme. The terms of this MoU may be amended by mutual consent of the Parties in writing. Participating faculties, staff and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the laws of the country and Rules and Regulations of the institutions.
- 17. This MoU shall be executed in triplicate with each Party keeping an original.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the Parties hereto, through their duly authorized representatives, have signed and executed this Memorandum of Understanding on the day, month and year mentioned herein.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS.

This Agreement places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either Party. GENERAL

- 1.3.4 Zaphire's computer algorithm and its representatives will screen and shortlist the students for various available opportunities based on skills, experience, job location, and any other fitment parameters necessary.
- 1.3.5 While the intent is to place as all qualified students as possible, there is no assurance from the Second Party on placement outcomes since this depends on a host of factors and fitment criteria.
- 1.3.6 If a student is successfully placed in a job/program/internship in which the client trains students / invest money in skill up-gradation but chooses to leave the job/program within 3 months from the start date for whatever reason OR is asked to leave for reasons of performance, conduct or any other reason, the First Party agrees to offer a suitable replacement candidate as soon as possible.

2. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

2.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights and designs) of the other Party.

3. VALIDITY

- 3.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, both Parties will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of either party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence, etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 3.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties must discharge their obligations as mutually discussed.

4. NON-CIRCUMVENTION

4.1 The First Party agrees not to engage with, directly or indirectly, the clients of the Second Party while the MOU is active.

5. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
- 5.2 It is also agreed that the First Party agrees to have the Second Party use the logo and branding for marketing purposes on the website, brochures, social media, and other media events to help get the required visibility and exposure for the students.
