Dr. Dakshayani Velayudhan
(Dakshayani Velayudhan was born to a lower-caste Palaya family in Travancore State, Palaya were among significant historians. As a young girl, Dakshayani defined her politics around by feminist caste-gender, such as gendering Palaya women from weaving, their name, wedding, education, etc. Dakshayani has the distinction of being the first woman Scheduled Caste member. She was elected to the Constituent Assembly from the Madras constituency in 1946. She was one of the 13 women members of the Constituent Assembly. She was also the youngest and the only Dalit woman member of the Constituent Assembly. She made her intervention on issues of untouchability, bonded labour, slavery, and many other pertinent concerns. Initially, her resolutions in the Assembly often led to her being criticised for making too many speeches.)


