PROJECT SUGAM

Project Sugam aims to build sustainable ecobrick bathrooms, across Delhi. This novel approach solves the dual problem of increasing plastic waste as well as the practice of open defecation, through construction of public toilets using Eco-bricks.



▶ Impacted **3** individuals directly.

▶ Impacted **20,708** individuals indirectly.

▶ Conducted recurring Anti-Plastic Campaigns, inaugurated by Padma Shri Gautam Gambhir. A monthly cycle yields more than **200 kgs of plastic** which is used in our production.

▶ We contributed plastic to an organisation, **ShynaEcoUnified**, that repurposes the same into tiles.

A training session was conducted for its beneficiaries by Ms.Kanchana Weerakoon, a Sri-Lankan ecobrick specialist.

Project Sugam this year was also able to raise more than Rs. 2,00,000 from crowdfunding on Milaap.

Procedures for borrowing crockery from the Steel Crockery Bank

1

JMC Crockery Bank Simple Process for Borrowing Crockery

(Guideline for the Borrowing Department/Society etc)

1. Fill in an application at least 4 to 7 working days before your event and get it approved from the principal. (available both at principal's office and crockery bank room number b 1)
2. Give the original copy with principal's signature to the crockery bank. Keep a duplicate copy for your reference.
3. JMC Crockery Bank will supply the required crockery items for FREE to any event/seminar/conference/parties organized by the College/ departments or / Societies / Staff / Non -Teaching staff Associations. However, you are required to pay a Refundable Security Deposit as a caution money for safe returning and Handling of borrowed crockery.
4. You are to give a Crossed Cheque favouring The Principal, Jesus and Mary College for the security deposit to the Crockery Bank Team Head / Member along with the application form. Please note that the cheque could be issued by a faculty/student member from their personal account and the cheque will be returned after the borrowed crockery is deposited with the bank.
5. The borrowing department has to undertake to get the crockery cleaned and dried from the Canteen staff whose name/s will be informed. Kindly ensure to pay the washing allowance DIRECTLY to the cleaning staff as per the rates given by the crockery bank.

6. Kindly COLLECT THE CROCKERY SETS on the date and time specified by the crockery bank AND COUNT IT BEFORE TAKING IT.
7. After the event is over, get the crockery cleaned and washed well and return all the borrowed crockery in good condition.
8. The crockery bank will return the security deposit cheque after receiving all the borrowed crockery.
9. In case of any loss or damage to the borrowed crockery items, the cost price of crockery will be charged in cash against a Receipt by the crockery bank (Cost Price and Security Rate Charts are available at the bank premises – Room Number B 1, Ground Floor).
10. In case the department/society/college etc engages a caterer who may use any banned plastic crockery items, the caterer is to be requested to use either safer crockery or told that the college steel crockery will be given at a nominal rent of Rs 3 per set (1 lunch thali, 1 steel glass and 1 spoon), which is only to send a message that there is no free ride for commercial purposes.

Report of e-waste awareness campaign and collection drive

On 25th September 2019, the BA Program Department's E-Waste Collection Drive was initiated at the conclusion of the E-Waste Awareness Campaign, conducted in the MPH, in collaboration with an NGO, Karo Sambhav. The drive lasted for the duration of a week, from 26th September to 3rd October 2019. As part of the drive, students were encouraged to donate old, unused or damaged electronic appliances in order to productively aid the environment and contribute to the creation of a better future.

Students could donate pen drives, remotes, mobiles, batteries, play stations, appliances containing electronic chips or wires, chargers, head phones, floppies, CDs, and any other electronic item that could be deemed as belonging under the heading of E-Waste. Collection points were strategically designated throughout the campus area of the institution, with bins being placed at the Common Room, the Principal's Lobby, the Photocopy Shop, the Bookstore, and the Staff Room.

Various incentives were announced to encourage the students to make the maximum possible contributions. Through the medium of the awareness campaign as well as online and offline promotions, information about the Collection Drive along with crucial knowledge about E-Waste was disseminated among the students. The response of the students was overwhelming as they fervently engaged in gathering old, damaged or unused electronic items from their homes and donating them at the collection points in a bid to participate in this pro-environment endeavour.

As the E-Waste Collection Drive came to a close, the total amount of E-Waste collected aggregated to an impressive 100 kilograms of donations. From first year, Angela of French-Philosophy, Tena Thapa of Computer Application-Mathematics, Nitya Alsa of Computer Application-Advertising, and Swarnima Singh of Elective English-French were considered to have made the most substantial contributions to the Collection Drive. From second year, the winners were Sephy of Computer Application-Mathematics, Sherry Joy of Computer Application-Advertising, Dhriti of Psychology-Philosophy and Ashni of Economics-Mathematics. From third year, Sugandha of Elective English-French, Manisha of Psychology-Philosophy, Liya of Elective English-History and Basant of Computer Applications-Advertising were adjudged to be the most significant contributors.

All the winners gained recognition and reward, in the form of certificates from the Department of BA Program, for their outstanding donations to the E-Waste Collection Drive. The E-Waste collected was handed over to the Karo Sambhav Yojna for further reuse and management in an eco-friendly manner. The Department of BA Program was accorded with the honour of receiving a certification for E-Waste Warriors, in light of its efforts to spread awareness about E-Waste and take concrete steps in the direction of eliminating and managing the same effectively.

The E-Waste Collection Drive was, thus, a resounding success in terms of its positive impact upon the student body as well as in achieving its objective of combating the contemporary problem



of proliferating E-Waste. The students and teachers of the BA Program Department all had a significant hand in its commendable accomplishments. The efforts and contributions of all those involved will hopefully go a long way in humanity's struggle to preserve the environment.

Swap Shop Meet Report

The JMC Staff Swap Shop Meet, the first of its kind, was held on the **28th of September 2019 in the Hall from 10:30 am to 2:30 pm**. The idea of organizing a Swap Shop Meet was conceptualised by **Ms. Purnima Topden** with an aim to introduce an innovative way to bring about an ideological shift in the clothes consumption patterns of students and staff. The focus was to reduce their carbon, water and waste footprint. This idea was first presented in front of the IQAC as part of an Action Plan for green initiatives that she was asked to work upon. Following this, the Action Plan for the Swap Shop Meet was presented in the next Staff Council Meeting.

Ms. Topden led the Swap Meet team that consisted of Ms. Ishita Singh, Ms. Kashish Dua and Ms. Meera Gopakumar. Each step of the Swap Meet was deliberated upon by the team and hours of work went into the logistics and the modalities. Posters for the campaign were designed by Ms. Ishita Singh. Emails with a detailed concept note attached were sent to all teachers. Retired staff members were also contacted and encouraged to participate.

The Swap Shop team conducted a week-long **collection drive** from **19th to 25th September** from 12:30 to 1 pm in the JMC staff room, during the break. A total of **193 items** ranging from clothes, accessories, bags and sarees were collected. The swap was limited to clothes that were unused, preferably with labels attached but for sarees vintage ones were accepted as well. The event roused a lot of interest amongst the current and retired staff who were excited to participate in something new that contributed to protecting the environment as well.

On the **26th and 27th of September**, the items collected were meticulously categorised and tagged. To enable a value-based smooth swap event, they were put into 5 categories ranging from A to E.

On the **28th of September**, the Swap Shop Meet was held from 10:30 am to 2:30 pm. The main objective in organising this event was to return as many items as possible into the circular economy through the exchange of as many items as possible. The goal was to extend the life of each item and reduce its carbon footprint. Teachers were pleasantly surprised to find that they could pick up interesting alternatives in exchange for things that were of no use for them, like gifts they had received that did not fit them, in colours they did not like etc. Many picked clothes for their family members. It was a very successful event that contributed to starting a dialogue and raising awareness on the polluting aspects of fast fashion and encouraging faculty members to reflect upon their own consumption practices. Most importantly, one could see the emergence of a new ethos of swapping clothes and things without the social stigma that was initially attached to it.

The goal was not to earn a profit by selling the items that were left after the swap. However, in the last hour, i.e. from 1:30-2:30 pm, we opened the event for sale of items at very nominal rates. The rest of the clothes were thereafter given for charity.

SEED BANK

Seed Bank (Collection of seeds) of various ecologically important trees, herbs and shrubs is also developed by Dr. Divya Agarwal. Important collected seeds are Parijat, *Ficus Benjamin*, Karri putta, Molshree, lemon, Saptaparni, *Bauhinia* species (Kachnar), Rama Tulsi, Shyama Tulsi and Vana Tulsi. Green society faculty members shall be contributing seed distribution program.

Enactus, JMC, under its Project Dhara banner diversified by introducing Seed Balls, a variety of different seeds rolled within a ball of manure and soil. In collaboration with WePlant, an NGO that attempts to save every seed possible through Seed Bank established in schools, colleges, companies etc. and plant them in public places. The team is in talks of setting up a seed bank at JMC and conducting plantation drives.
