Jesus and Mary College Educational Programme (JMCEP)

"One child, one teacher, one book, and one pen can change the world."

- Malala Yousafzai

The quote mentioned above succinctly reflects the spirit of JMCEP. Since its inception in 1979, the relentless collective efforts of JMCEP volunteers in imparting education to children from marginalized sections of society have been instrumental in bringing about a positive difference to their lives as well as those of others. In the NAAC Report (2015), it has been accorded the 'best practice' of the college.

In the academic year 2016-2017, 150 students from the college registered as members of JMCEP to teach 176 children between nursery to Class XI from neighboring colonies of Bapu Dham, Vivekananda Camp, and children of construction workers residing within the campus. Lakshita Iyer (Sociology, 3rd year) and Sharon Pandi Kabo (Political Science, 2nd year) were elected president and vice-president respectively. Core team members were also elected to assist in the activities of the society.

The JMCEP classes were conducted in the afternoon from Monday to Friday. In collaboration with other societies and NGOs, various activities were organized throughout the year aiming at the holistic development of children. The teachers, Ms. Charu Gupta, Ms. Usha Udaar, and Ms. Sonika Chauhan constantly guided us in the process.

Collaboration with Enactus: On 8th September, 2016, the societies came together to spread awareness about dengue and chikungunya to the children. Various

ways of prevention and protection against the flu were explained and discussed. As a part of the awareness drive, Odomos tubes were also distributed to the children.

Film Screening for Children: On 20th October, 2016, 'The Jungle Book' was screened for children, marking the end of their examinations. The children enjoyed every bit of it. It seemed to be an immersive experience for them as they talked about and could feel the characters' sufferings and joys as their own after the screening. Ankita Mehra (Political Science, 2nd year) presented a brief conclusion focusing on the issue of sensitizing people about the lives of animals and their participation in the various forces on earth.

Documentary Screening: On 18th January, 2017, a documentary titled 'A Teacher's Journey' was screened for the volunteers. The documentary, through actual classroom episodes from a single teacher school in India, highlights challenges and joys of teaching. And most importantly discusses what it takes to be a teacher. It also covers certain innovative practices that the teachers and students co-engaged with in a multi-level classroom. After the screening, JMCEP students, with a renewed motivation and enthusiasm, shared their own JMCEP journeys with the children so far — recollecting and reflecting on their experiences, sharing the ups and downs.

Collaboration with CRY: Various activities, including storytelling, art and craft sessions, were organized for children in collaboration with Child Rights and You to stimulate imagination and free expression. A book collection drive was initiated in collaboration with CRY and NSS in January, wherein hundreds of children's books were being contributed by college students. Books collected were later being used for the storytelling and reading sessions with children. Storytelling paved the path for incorporating rich and meaningful ways of enhancing the skills of speaking, reading and writing. It has been decided the team will gift these books to the children as a token of appreciation for being an integral part of the programme.

Outdoor Activities: Learning is not confined to the four walls of the classroom. In February, outdoor events were held for children, wherein the children were divided into different groups, and they actively took part in games planned for them by the volunteers, encouraging cooperation, coordination and team work.

By helping to learn and learning to help, students explored creative ways of organizing activities with and for children. The JMCEP experience exposed students to grass root realities, and brought about a realization of inequitable distribution of resources, in general, and educational inequities, in particular. They could now reflect on their own position in the society vis-à-vis the position of 'others' with respect to the possession of power and privileges. Through the programme, students were being provided a platform to take small steps toward the process of change they want to see around themselves.

Each member was asked to engage in voluntary work with an NGO with the underprivileged in orphanages, old age homes and slum areas, in addition to in-house activities. In addition to this, a talk was organised on 11 September 2019 on: "*Transformative Education Leadership and Nation Building: Basis of Research Methodology*" by the society advisors. This event helped the students understand the issues and challenges in research methodologies.

In order to encourage and impart public speaking skills, a Debate competition was organised on 16 October 2019 on the theme: "This House believes that education is closely linked with the question of modernity." The competition was bilingual, i.e. the speakers were allowed to speak either in Hindi or English. There were six participants. Among them, two participants were in favour of the motion and four were against the motion.

To inculcate the values of liberty, equality and fraternity among the students, the AICUF screened a documentary movie "Nero's Guests: The Age of Inequality" on 23 October 2019. The film brought to light the odd predicament faced by our nation even today, i.e., farmer suicides. It is an issue that has often been side lined for a long time. The film in itself was highly thought provoking and helped students understand the various challenges faced by the marginals in our country. Meanwhile, a group discussion was organised on 6 November 2019 on: "Creative Ideas for Resounding Success." The main objective of the event was to mentor and guide the students for the upcoming university and competitive exams for all streams and help them take wise decisions about their future. In order make the society events more interactive and interesting for the students, the whole society was divided into 6 small groups. Each group was headed by a society advisor. And sessions were conducted with the central theme: "Leadership in 21st Century." Each group had interesting discussions and interactions. The students participated

Remedial Classes Report

Remedial coaching is organized at the undergraduate level with a view to improve academic and linguistic proficiency of the students in various subjects. To reduce the failure and/or drop-out rate of students belonging to SC, ST, OBC and Minority communities pursuing higher education, UGC had started providing financial assistance for conducting special classes outside the regular time table during the 11th Plan.
