Affirmative Actions to be taken in order to ensure discipline, cleanliness and security in the college premises.

Concern raised about safety of girls travelling in 4 passenger autos.

As the concern has been raised about the safety of girls travelling in 4 passenger autos, there is a need to create awareness and responsibility among JMC students also. Hence EACH DEPT will be requested to make 2 posters saying the slogan "Avoid illegal, unsafe and unbecoming practices" and mentioning in bold that students should sit in 3 passenger autos rather than 4 passengers. The posters are to be pinned on notice boards.

Cleanliness

- Notice Boards : Telling all societies to remove their posters once the event, audition or activity is over. (on the day the event gets over everything should be removed)
- Student council committee to keep scan over notice boards every week
- Cleanliness- Students ambassadors or compulsory society's one section is dedicated to cleanliness of the college and events.
- Keeping dustbins after every __m in the campus
- Instilling a sense of responsibility by doing a campaign every month on cleanliness
- Doing a swachh bharat abhiyaan drive one day/month at random and positively reinforcing the behaviour

Quieter Corridors

As appraised by council convenors about the need for quieter corridors. Each college department will be asked to make 3 posters each stating "SILENCE ZONE" in bold which will be pasted using cello tape outside the classroom door and pinned on the notice boards in the corridors.

Noise outside the classroom is an issue. For example, excessive noise in corridors during exam time will be a distraction to those undertaking examinations, or it can cause interruptions to normal classroom teaching.

Proposed solutions:

- Create quiet zones in classrooms, corridors, exam rooms and libraries by putting up notices
- The Org committee can do a check after every hour on each floor to maintain decorum
- Volume can be positively/ negatively reinforced
- Teachers and student ambassadors can keep a whistle which can be blown if the sound levels reach beyond a limit and this rule can be informed to all students.

College Bulletin Boards

All departments were requested to remove old notices by 25th of September and will be asked to further maintain it and renew it every 3 months with new themes related to environment and current affairs related informative material.

Sanitation and Hygiene

- Initiating a talk with a sponsor for sanitary napkin facilities in the college.
- Initiating sanitation and hygiene campaigns which the Org committee can do, so that girls maintain cleanliness within the washrooms
- Even though pipelines have been installed, regularity of water service is an issue in washrooms and drinking. This also is a barrier for sports students and needs to be brought to Sister's notice.

Code of Conduct for the Students' Council

1. To promote the interests of all students at JMC in order to create a safe and good learning and school environment
2. To express its views and present proposals to the school leadership in matters relating to school and neighbourhood environment
3. Notice board maintenance with proper themes that are relevant to everyday issues.
4. Quieter Corridors; Delegating duties to presidents and Vice President of various department floor wise to maintain more silence in corridors. (used posters and social media messages to reinforce)

5. Cleanliness; around college through various mechanisms, provision of more dustbins on the day of various events. Spreading awareness about cleanliness etc
6. Facilities provision; clean drinking water and water supply in washroom. Water coolers
